We had almost all of the vendor spaces sold out thanks to Milt, and Sandy did great with the raffle (we may need extra tables for next years raffle)!

With the overdraw in entries we had to add 4 more judges. Onofrio's did a great job on the scheduling especially for the two shows on Friday. With the increase in entries we were first told that back to back we would be there until midnight. They then got AKC's approval to run the shows concurrently and with their scheduling we were done with both BIS's by 6:30 PM! The Obedience Trials ran a little later finishing up around 8:45 PM. It looks like we will be doing it again next year!

Delegates Report

AKC Delegates Report—June 2018

The second quarterly Delegates Meeting for the year was held on Tuesday, June 12, 2018 in Newark, NJ. The Delegate Standing Committee meetings were held on June 11, 2018, in the same location. Of interest at the All Breeds Committee meeting was the announcement that AKCTV will have the AKC Education Summit which was held on Sunday, June 11, broadcast so that everyone can benefit from watching this informative event. There was also discussion of the requirement of back to back shows on the same day limiting each judge to 100 dogs for the first show with a maximum of 175 for the entire day. This is due to the lengthy day some clubs were creating with the scheduling of back to back shows on the same day. Glenn Lycan was in attendance to discuss the 1+1=1 point concept which will be effective in the near future. This new rule states that as long as there is 1 class dog and 1 class bitch present, Best of Winners will receive 1 point toward their championship. This will be especially helpful with the low entry breeds.

The presentation at Delegates Forum, which preceded the meeting, was entitled “Domestic Supply of Explosives Detection Dogs” presented by AKC Detection Dog Task Force members: Dr. Carmen Battaglia, Mark Dunn and Penny Leigh. The program included a live demonstration by a certified explosives detection dog and a question and answer discussion with a member of the TSA regarding the lack of detection dogs we are producing in this country and the collaboration with the AKC and TSA to help remedy the need.

President Dennis Sprung called the meeting to order at 10:00 am and introduced those seated with him on the dais.

The Executive Secretary read the names of the Delegates seated since the last meeting, and those Delegates in attendance who were attending their first meeting were introduced from the floor.

The Sloughi and Neopolitan Mastiff breed clubs were voted into membership.

The President and Chief Financial Officer gave their respective reports, which are worthy of your review and can be found in their entirety on the AKC Website at www.akc.org. Of special note is that in 2018 there is a 6% increase thus far in both dogs and litters over last year

AKC's Doug Ljungren gave the 2018 “State of the Sport” address. AKC does 25 different sports with 20,000 events and 3.1 million entries in 1 year. Conformation and Obedience, and traditional Performance Event are down. CGC, Modern Performance Events (CAT, FASCAT, SCENTWORK),

The following amendments were voted on and were adopted:

Chapter 6, Section 2, and Chapter 16, Section 1, of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*—Premium Lists and Closing of Entries, which in Chapter 6, Section 2, would move a sentence from an italicized sentence in Chapter 16, Section 1, to this section as part of the Rules; and would move a sentence to Chapter 6, Section 2, - Championships, which addresses premium list requirements.

Chapter 7, Section 2, of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, Judges, which would change “license” to “approval”.

Chapter 7, Section 12, of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*-Judges, which would bring consistency to this section to allow for electronic communication and change the italicized sentence to part of the rule.

Chapter 7, Section 19, of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*- Judges, which would make the italicized sentence part of the rule and removes the recommendation that the Best in Show judge be someone that has not already judged that day. Currently, the only hardship cases that are approved are day of event judge cancellations.

The following amendments were read and will be voted on at the September 25th meeting:

Chapter 1, Section 4, of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* – Dog Shows Defined, which would allow clubs to limit their event by the number of dogs or by the total entry.

Chapter 5, Section 9, of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* – Ribbons, Prizes and Trophies, which would allow a club to offer a three-time win trophy for Reserve Best in Show.

Chapter 3, Section 16, of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* – Dog Show Classifications, which would specify the order in which awards are presented by a judge at an All-Breed Show. The amendment was brought forward by the Delegate Dog Show Rules Committee and unanimously disapproved by the AKC Board at the February 2018 Board meeting. The Dog Show Rules Committee is requesting that this amendment go forward to the Delegates for a vote as per the AKC Bylaws.

Chapter 11, New Section 16, of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* – Dog Show Entries, Conditions of Dogs Affecting Eligibility, to address the inappropriate collars and leads at dog shows. The amendment was brought forward by the Delegate Dog Show Rules Committee and unanimously disapproved by the AKC Board at the February 2018 Board meeting. The Dog Show Rules

Committee is requesting that this amendment go forward to the Delegates for a vote as per the AKC Bylaws.

The next Delegates Meeting will take place on September 25, 2018 in Newark, NJ.

Health Tips!

[Dog Myths Debunked: Can I Leave My Dog in the Car If I Crack a Window?](#) By Anna Burke

Most dog owners know that you can't leave a pet in a hot car. Temperatures can rise to dangerous levels in just minutes, putting your dog at risk of heat stroke. But what if you slightly open a window? The answer is simple: you should NEVER leave a dog alone in the car, even with the windows cracked. In some states, it's even illegal.

Why Cracking a Window Isn't Enough

It doesn't have to be super hot outside for your car to heat up. The inside of a vehicle parked in 70-degree weather can reach 100 degrees in just 20 minutes. On very hot days, temperatures inside parked cars can climb to 140 degrees Fahrenheit in under an hour. According to the [American Veterinary Medical Association \(AVMA\)](#), studies have shown that cracking a window changes these figures very little. A parked car with the windows cracked heats up at almost the exact same rate as a car with the windows rolled up, putting pets in serious danger.

Car Safety

All dogs are susceptible to [heat stroke](#). Heat intolerant brachycephalic breeds (dogs that have a relatively broad, short skull), such as [Pugs](#) and [Bulldogs](#), however, could suffer negative effects sooner than other breeds. If you know you'll have to be on the road with your dog, make plans to travel with another adult who can remain in the vehicle with him while the air conditioner is running. This will keep him safe, and it will also reduce the risk of your dog jumping out of an open window at a rest stop or in a parking lot.

Hundreds of pets die from car-related heat stroke each year. The issue is so important that [27 states have laws](#) about pets that are left unattended in vehicles. Some laws ban the practice outright, while others protect law enforcement officers and citizens if they break into cars to rescue pets.

As summer gets underway, the risk of heat stroke, both in and outside of cars, grows. Stay on top of high temperatures with the [AKC Link collar](#). This smart collar sends you an alert when your dog is exposed to temperatures that are either too hot or too cold for him, helping you keep him safe, no matter where he is.
