Information for New Artist Applicants

Membership Benefits

- Gallery Display: Each artist receives approximately 10 feet of wall space and 2 feet for prints (for 2D artists) or 12 display surfaces (for 3D artists), depending on membership numbers. Card racks are also available for cards or print display.
- **Professional Presentation:** Showcase your work in a beautiful, light-filled gallery with a professional yet welcoming atmosphere.
- **Community & Collaboration:** Work alongside fellow artists in a friendly, supportive, artfocused environment.
- Online Presence & Marketing:
 - o Your artist page with a bio and images on our website (ebbtideart.com).
 - Regular promotion on Facebook ("The Ebb Tide Art Gallery") and Instagram ("Ebb Tide Gallery").
 - o Internal communication via our private Facebook group ("Ebb Tide Members Only").

Membership Requirements

• **Jurying Process:** Membership is based on artwork screening by current members and an interview with the screening committee.

• Commitment:

- o A 12-month contract is required.
- o First and last month's rent are due upon signing.
- o Monthly rent: Currently \$135, due on the first of each month (prorated if applicable).
- Commission: The gallery retains a 15% pre-tax commission on all sold work to cover operating expenses.

• Business & Tax Compliance:

- o Artists must have a Washington State Unified Business ID Number
- o Artists are responsible for reporting and paying Washington State sales tax.

• Gallery Participation:

- Work approximately five (5) 4-hour shifts per month (flexible scheduling based on membership numbers).
- o Attend monthly membership meetings (last Thursday of the month).
- o Actively participate in at least one gallery committee (e.g., Display, Membership, Community Liaison, Publicity, Events).

Application & Screening Process

- 1. Complete an application form.
 - a. Available in person or online at ebbtideart.com.
 - b. Return the completed application to Ebb Tide Gallery.
- 2. Submit 5 -6 gallery-ready samples of your art to the gallery for jurying.
 - a. Artwork should be priced, framed (if appropriate), and ready to hang.

- b. Artists must sign a **Hold Harmless Agreement** for art left at the gallery during the screening.
- 3. Ebb Tide gallery members will jury submissions.
 - a. Screenings are typically held on the last Thursday of each month.
 - b. The applicant will be notified by phone or e-mail of the screening results.
 - c. If not accepted, the applicant's submitted art will be ready for pick up the following day.
 - d. If accepted, the applicant will move onto an in-person interview.
- 4. Accepted applicant will schedule an in-person interview with several Ebb Tide artists.
 - a. This is an opportunity for both the applicant and members to ask questions and discuss expectations.

Finalizing Membership

- 5. If the applicant and members agree that this will be a good fit for both parties:
 - a. Contract will be signed.
 - b. First and last month's rent will be paid.
 - c. Introduction to key members of the gallery
 - i. Calendar coordinator
 - ii. Board members
 - d. Orientation day(s) will be scheduled.
 - e. Welcome to the Ebb Tide Gallery!
