Three Lake Lid [TLID] Annual Meeting: August 19, 2017

Please mark Saturday, August 19, 2017 on your calendar and plan to attend the second TLID annual meeting. The meeting will be held at the Palmer Town Hall at 10:00 AM. All property owners of record on Rush, Julia, Briggs and the Bayou are considered TLID members and are encouraged to participate. The TLID was organized to address Aquatic Invasive Species, Water Stabilization and Water Quality. The annual meeting is required by MN Statutes, and allow TLID members to know what is going on, and to have a voice in projects for the following year. Here is what to expect:

- Meeting will last about an hour to hour and a half
- Review and adoption of 2016 annual meeting minutes
- Review of 2016 TLID activities and revenues/expenses
- Reports from directors and advisor
- Update and status of lake vegetation management plan
- Discussion of proposed TLID projects for 2018, including water stabilization feasibility study and water quality.
- Adoption of by-laws
- Election of TLID Directors
- Adoption of 2018 budget

Member comments

All property owners within the TLID are eligible to vote for directors and the 2018 budget, which includes proposed projects. TLID members may vote by absentee ballot for directors, but not for the 2018 budget. All property owners will receive by hard mail an official notice of the Annual Meeting. Three director positions are open: you may nominate yourself using the application form [included with annual meeting notice], or be nominated "from the floor" at the annual meeting.
