Officer Reports:

Chair: May 31st there is a meet and Greet for the Sherburne Cty Coala at the Lions park in Big Lake from 6-8.

Sherburne Cty water plan is now on their web site

Vice-Chair: Lake Orono is getting funding for a draw down with dredging

Secretary: A confirmed list of assessment properties will be sent out before next meeting. There are discrepancies with the county list.

Advisor: Elk River Watershed would like to see the Wenck report on water stabilization.

Old Business:

James Johnson went over some details of the LVP he came up with for the TLID.

Separate all three lakes when going for any variances.

Do we want to get a variance for Rush to do more than 15%? We will look at this year results and weed crop before going forward. This should be done in late summer or early fall.

The LVP should be used for having a discussion with our weed sprayer or with the DNR.

Delineation study for CLP should be done in late fall for the next spraying season.

For milfoil it should be done in late June until fall

Point Intercept Survey should be done every 3-5 years. There is a need for one when going for a variance.

Approx cost – Rush and Julia \$2000.00 each. Briggs 3-4 Thousand.

Each year Rush and the Briggs side of the channel should be checked.

Keep doing what we are doing until something changes or we are not satisfied with what is going on.

If we go for a variance to eradicate more plants we would need to do native planting in order to replace what will be killed by spraying.

Wenck Report – Each director should come to the next meeting with 1-2 priorities for discussion on the report. Also think of ideas as to how this will be presented to the members at the annual meeting.

The Wenck report will be put on the TLID web site

The Survey Grant from the SCWD from last year will need to be finalized so the TLID can get their final payment.

Steve D pulled his suggestion of putting in the budget money for training members to be AIS inspectors at the landing. Money should be in the budget for hiring inspectors through the SCWD (Water Guards) Enough money for 200 hrs was suggested. $200 \text{ hrs} \times \$18.00 \text{ hrs} = \3600 .
