**Officer Reports:**

**Chair:** 60 people including 10 from the BLCA attended the COALA Open House

An Eagle Scout made Zebra Mussel detectors that will be used in all 4 lakes. 3 on Briggs and 2 for the other 3 lakes. He will give a presentation at the BLCA picnic on Saturday 6-9

**Vice-Chair:** Water testing started the Tuesday after Memorial day

## **Old Business:**

James Johnson has submitted the final LVP and invoice. They have been forwarded to the SCWD for final grant payment.

Proposal from James Johnson to do Survey for Milfoil.

\$2330.00 for the upper lakes and \$800.00 for Elk since it is separate and paid by the BLCA

Pont Intercept Survey will cost \$1670.00 for Rush and will give us a base line for weeds. Suggested to have an area of about 150 yards of Briggs by the channel to Rush be included

Paul motioned and Jim A 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the Intercept Survey be done

## Wenck Report

Kenzie talked to the area Hydrologist from the DNR and was told the fish barrier at the dam could be removed with permits. Also there is talk from the DNR to declassify Briggs Creek as a trout stream. This could open possible water storage that was stated in the Wenck report

Possible report recommendations –

Remove fish barrier – Cost?

Built a raise able barrier – Cost?

Water flow data for Bayou during high water.

Recommended to hand off fish barrier part of report to the BLCA and Healthy Lakes. Recommend barrier cleanout schedule.

Steve will contact SCWD for direction on Bayou water flow.

Spraying has been completed on the upper lakes. Individual spraying will begin soon.

A resident on the north end of Rush was concerned that there was no spraying done in that area. Mike F will check out the weeds that are present.

Complaints have been received about the spraying notification signs being left out in the water.
