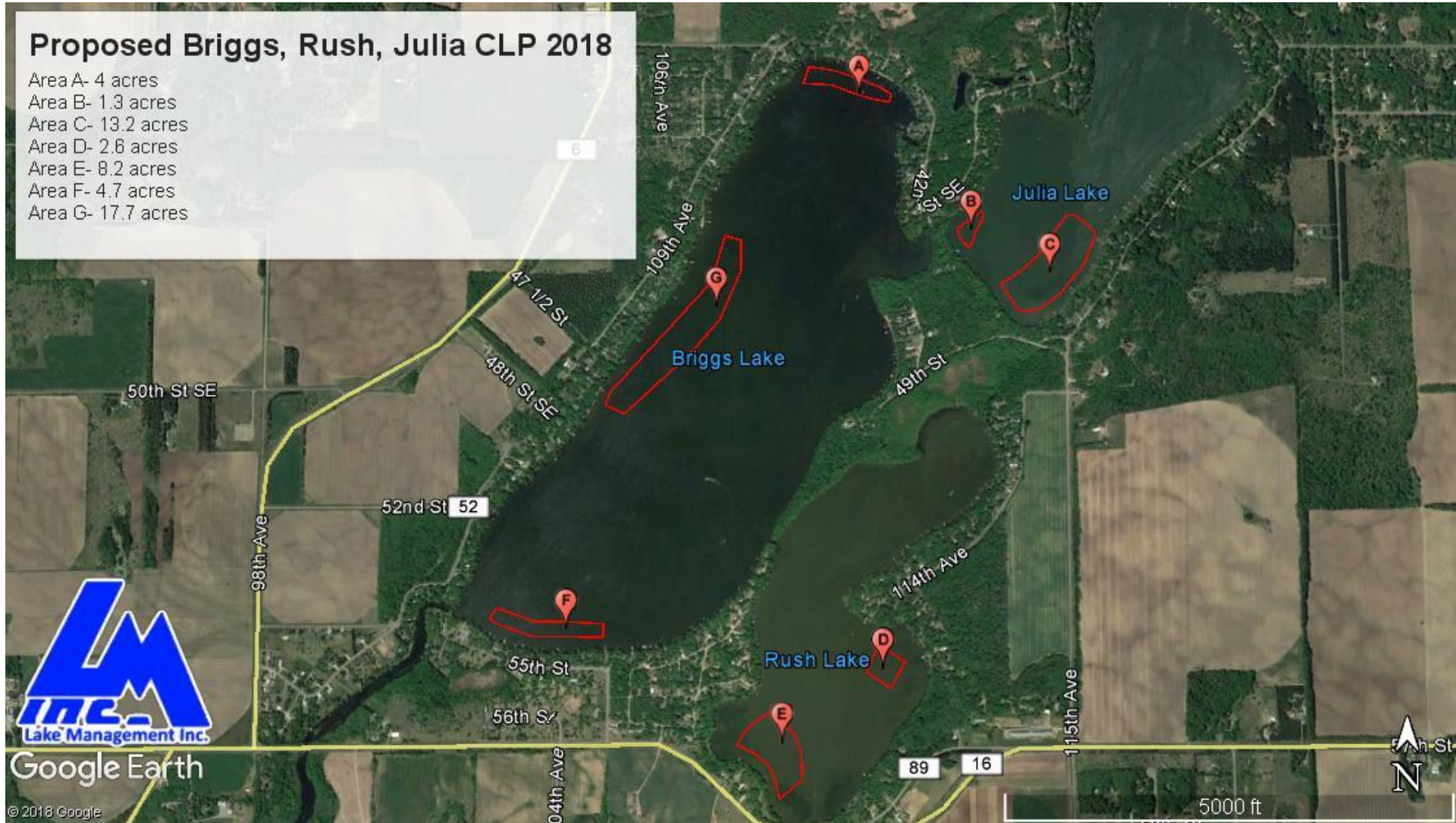

- Aug Waterfront Restoration hand pulls EWM (Rush) ?

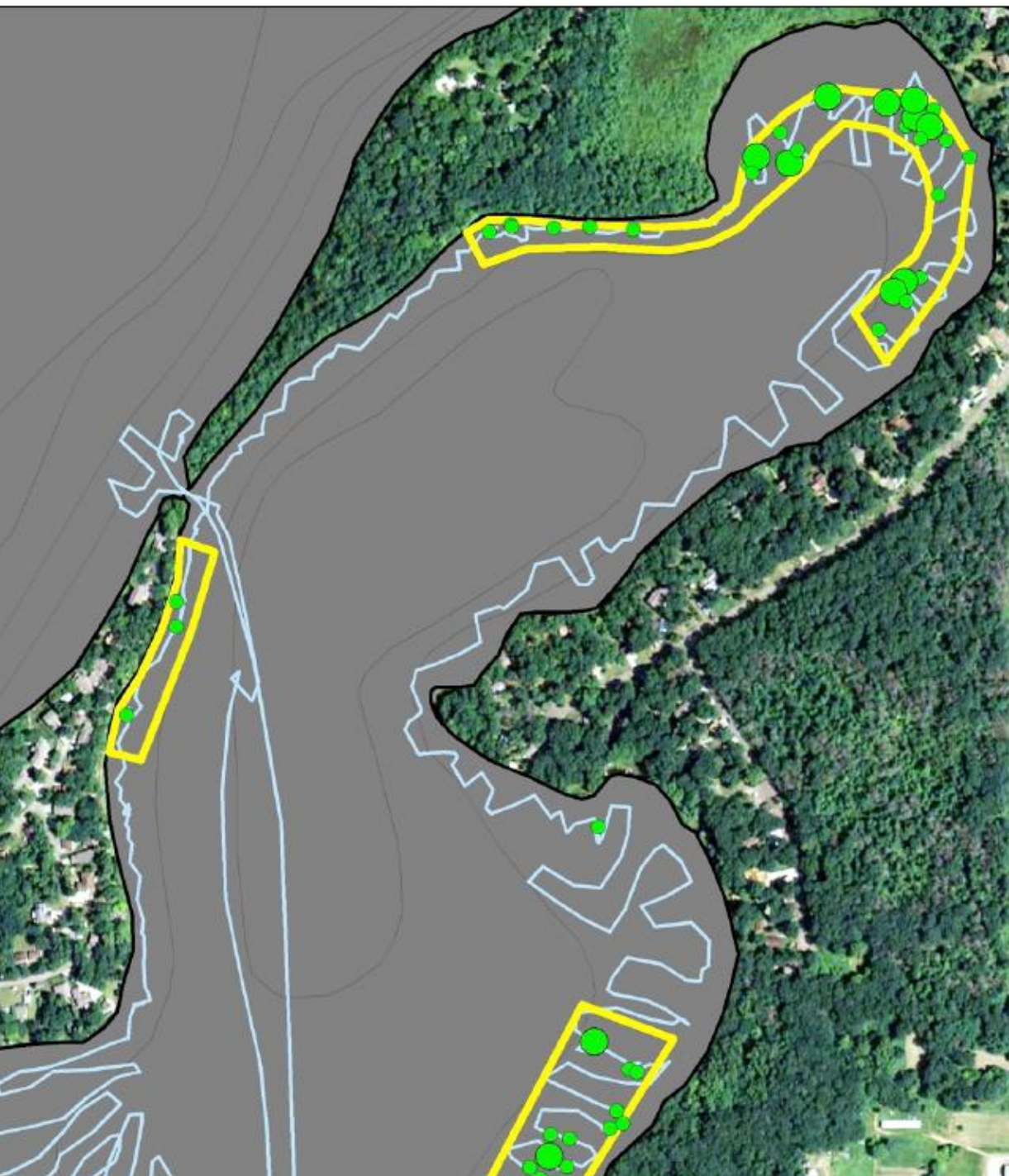

# Lake Vegetation Management Plan (LVMP) Update

- What the heck is the LVMP ?
  - Game plan: Lake usage versus environmental factors affecting water quality
  - Identifying and planning for additional threats to our lakes puts us in a better position to be proactive rather than reactive.
  - Helps us to identify where the lakes are/may become negatively affected
    - Impaired navigation, swimmer safety, etc
  - Allows us to potentially enhance lakes uses
    - Water quality, fish habitat, etc
  - Provides up to date information for grant writing
