Alum Treatments – discussion was held as to the use of Alum treatment to help rid of algae. Scott has been contacted by a company who can apply. The current company we use for weed spraying does not apply Alum. James Johnson stated that it would be good to start with a small area in the Bayou and that no permits were needed to apply. Approx cost is \$1000.00 and acre. PLM is a local company that offers Alum Treatment. BLCA will dicuss bringing in consultants to learn more of this process. There has been a lot of talk over the years about this treatment and more credible information is needed. More to come.

Discussion was held as to the need to hold TLID meetings each month. More discussion will be done. Nothing will be done until presented at the annual meeting.

It was decided that Lake Management will do the spraying again in 2019. The board felt that communications with Lake Management and the TLID were improved in 2018
