- TLID update TLID is continuing to prepare for the annual meeting in August. Curly Leaf Pondweed has been treated. James Johnson will do a follow-up survey in July to check for Eurasian Milfoil (including Big Elk Lake)
- Water Testing update water testing and clarity monitoring has started. Volunteers will continue to check clarity and take samples though out the summer.
- Sherburne County Park Update (Wiese property) nothing new to report.
- Big Lake LID Status A letter has been drafted to be sent to the commissioners by a resident of Big Elk Lake.
- Gentle Footprint Projects and Grants/SWCD money Chuck will be at the annual Briggs Lake Chain Association Meeting on June 11 with information and a presentation.
- Golden Clam update The DNR is encouraging us to check for Golden Clams around our shoreline. They have found 162 year to date and all have been near the Briggs Lake landing.
- 2021 Healthy Lakes Goals The Sherburne County Board of Adjustments is undergoing changes which could affect our representation (Palmer Township) we were encouraged to write letters to Nancy Riddle stating that we want to be represented.
