#### **Officer Reports:**

**Chair**: Thin Ice signs are installed by the spillway on the west property. Water patrol asked if we wanted a warning buoy in front of the spillway. They said it is not required. The TLID would like to see it to ease fear of boats damaging the spillway.

We have been approved for up to \$13,200.00 in DNR grant money. This may go down after the spring survey determines the amount of spraying needed. But we are maxed out at that sum. The SWCD grant that we applied for on spraying could be reduced depending on the DNR amount. The SWCD doesn't want to see organizations get double grant payments for spraying.

TLID will be sending a check of \$3800.00 to the SWCD for 2020 boat inspections at the upper three lakes. That will be 200 hrs to be divided equal among the three lakes. SWCD will also sponsor 100 additional hrs on Briggs and 50 hrs on Rush. Under their formula Julie will not see inspection hrs other than the ones bought by the TLID.
