Chair: Paul Hans is moving and will no longer be eligible to be on the Board. He has handed in his resignation effective immediately.

Old Business:

Annual Meeting: All agreed that the meeting went smooth. All questions were answered and the Board was prepared. Bayou update: River has been stable for weeks now so no data collection has taken place.

Special meeting Oct 16th: there will be a special meeting to take about water stabilization. Members of the TLID, BLCA, Healthy Lakes, SWCD, and DNR will be invited. Dan C from SWCD will set the agenda and direct the meeting. Meeting will need to be posted for open meeting rules.

Grants: DNR will be offering Grants again.

Navigational Aids: Sherburne Cty Deputy Cole asked if any additional Buoys or signs were needed on the lakes. The TLID would recommend that the Sherriff monitor the placement of the buoys more often as they seem to move during the season. More slow no wake signs at the channels between lakes would also be recommended.

Resolution for 2020Assessment – Walt motioned and Harry 2nd to approve the assessment of the TLID members for 2020 Motioned passed.

Discussion was held for possible replacement for outgoing board member Paul Hans. All board members should thing and look at possible candidates. The board would like to see someone in place before thanksgiving.

Harry E and Nancy H took a trip to Little Rock Lake to observe the draw down activities. There have been 45,000 planting done. They also talked to some locals. CLP in the lake has been controlled by using granular herbicide done by a company out of Clearwater. They have seen a 50% increase in water quality.

River Bulrush plants have worked the best for our 3 lakes when introduced in 2005.

Walt mentioned that the sechi disc reading that was taken the last time showed a 1 ft increase in better reading.
