Grant Update: Scott reported that we will receive a DNR grant for treatment of curly leaf pondweed spraying for this summer on all three lakes. The amount is \$9,500. Kenzie said that there is a Conservation Partners Legacy Grant. We could qualify for money under the category "wetlands water level control structures". It's too late for us to put together a request for this year but we will watch for this grant next year.

James Johnson Update: Scott shared the signed contract with James for early EWM surveys and end of year surveys also.

New AIS in Briggs Update: Golden Clams were found on Briggs near the landing last fall. The DNR and the U of M have been monitoring them and will continue throughout the year. They have included residents in their monitoring sessions. The clams seem to have survived the winter.

Other: Mike presented an estimate to install water level monitoring systems in our lake (most likely one in the river and one in the bayou). There was a discussion and some concerns about a possible monthly fee. Mike will check with Dan and Paul Schriber and get their views on this system. It would give us real time measurements and a accurate view of our fluctuating water levels which could be beneficial as we move forward in our stabilization plans. Mike will report back at our next meeting.
