




## JOSEPH BAY TRADE SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

### Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- \* Seeking graduating seniors with an interest in attending a trade or technical school.
- \* Application must include transcript from high school, including two letters of recommendation (must not be a family member).
- \* Completed applications, including your two letters of recommendation and high school transcript, must be submitted to your respective high school Counselor no later than **April 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year**. Type or print legibly please. Applicants who do not meet the eligibility requirements and/or fail to submit the required documentation on time will not be accepted.
- \* The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by the JDBMSF Scholarship Committee.

- \* Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the trade or technical school upon receiving a certificate of enrollment or registration statement from the student that includes the Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address. ## SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Joseph D. Bay Memorial Scholarships are awarded to students who wish to pursue a career in the trade or technology field.

### **Application process:**

1. Contact your school counselor for application and guidelines.
2. Request an application via email [ScholarshipCommitteeJDBMSF@gmail.com](mailto:ScholarshipCommitteeJDBMSF@gmail.com).

### **Deadline date:**

1. April 1st is the deadline for all applications to be completed and turned into your school counselor.

### **Disbursement of scholarship funds:**

1. Once the student enrolls in their respective school and has forwarded confirmation of such enrollment to [ScholarshipCommitteeJDBMSF@gmail.com](mailto:ScholarshipCommitteeJDBMSF@gmail.com) (student I.D., registration statement, etc.), the Joseph D. Bay Memorial Scholarship Fund will disburse funds in the student's name directly to the said trade or technical school listed on their application.
2. If said funds are not expended within one year of the student's graduation date, the scholarship funds will be withdrawn.
3. If the student decides, with or without notice to us, not to go to school after registering and after the scholarship funds have already been sent to said school, the Scholarship Committee will request the scholarship funds be withdrawn and returned to us, regardless of the timeframe.
