### Entry Information:

- This event will be run under current HCBC rules.
- Late entries may be accepted if there are time slots still available and accompanied by a \$15 late fee per test.
- Payments will be made out to Hoofbeats Therapeutic Riding Association (cheques) or e-transferred to hoofbeatstra@gmail.com
- Each rider will be assigned a ride time before show day; ride times will be posted to the Hoofbeats TRA Facebook page and emailed to riders; please ensure the email included on the entry is accurate.

### General Information:

- As this is a schooling show, each rider will have brief scheduled feedback with the judge immediately following the completion of their test.
- All riders must have current HCBC membership and a signed waiver on file in order to participate.
- Camping is available for \$15/night if required. No hookups available.
- Limited overnight pens are available for \$15/night, self penning is available for no charge in the camping area. Please clean up your pen prior to departure.
- Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined or cancelled at the discretion of the show committee.
- A junior competitor is a competitor 18 years old or younger as of January 1, 2026. A senior competitor is a competitor 19 years old or older as of January 1, 2026.
- Refunding of entry fees will only be allowed with a vet or doctor's certificate of inability of the horse or rider to compete. Must be presented to the show office before the first class in order to receive a refund.
- All competitors must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets and proper riding boots.
- Para dressage riders may use any style of well fitted saddle, and may use adaptive equipment as required.

It is the responsibility of the show/event committee, or competition organizers and the facility owners and managers to ensure that all BC Health Authority and WorkSafeBC directives are followed and enforced. Horse Council is not a regulatory body, and it is understood and agreed that sanctioning and approval of a HCBC Provincial competition / event relates to the use of the rule book and approved officials only.

This Competition is a Horse Council BC provincially sanctioned competition and will be governed in accordance with the Horse Council BC Rule Book. Knowledge of the rules is the responsibility of Competition Management, Officials and Competitors.

Neither Horse Council BC, its Board of Directors, organizing committee, staff, volunteers, officials, or employees of the horse show, will be responsible in any way, for damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses or property of exhibitors, spectators, owners, riders, trainers, or grooms. All competitors and owners of horses must be members of Horse Council BC to participate
