1. Welcome, Land Acknowledgment - Jim Spyropoulous and Melanie Laking

Jim opened with Land acknowledgement, and thanks to Jill for inviting him and Melanie to the meeting

Melanie spoke on behalf of Kapapamahchakwew Wandering Spirit Indigenous food sovereignty – looking to move from food security (filling bellies) to indigenous food sovereignty (i.e. foods normally part of an indigenous diet).

Melanie shared a teaching on the Dish with One Spoon Treaty. The land that our schools are on is under this treaty. The Dish with One Spoon Treaty helps people to manage overlap in shared territories. It sees the land and resources as a dish and we all have a right to that dish and we have a responsibility to steward for 7 generations.
