### **Community Discussion:**

1) TDSB Budget Update - the process is still playing out, TDSB waiting to hear GSN fund amounts, Education Minister did not accept TDSB selling properties to balance budget, can find all TDSB TRustee meeting on the website, there are Budge Town Halls next week (info in the NTR, TDSB email and Trustee email), 65% of Budget is Staff (85% Staff & Benefits) that's why staff cuts are part of balancing budget every year

Duke did get back 1 Lunchroom Supervisor for next school year

2) Outdoor Beautification - Emily Harris-Mcleod

Outdoor areas and fences could use some jazzing up - projects like art for the fences, gardens, vines grown on the fences, etc. Murals on the concrete walls in the back field. Ground painting - hopscotch, 4 square

Front basketball court to be done this year - resurfacing and painting (4 square, etc)
Parents can't just paint things themselves - TDSB policy
Could tie this in with the Kindness Initiative

SC & Principal to explore what is allowed and can be done guickly/easily/economically
