Treasurer's Report (Jeff)

Overview of the incoming and outgoing funds from School Council accounts.

Since the previous meeting, a total of \$53 has come in through pizza lunch revenue. A total of \$3,526 was spent on various activities which includes payment for the dance-a-thon, Kindergarten Prologue, PALS and Breakout room items, Pizza lunch expenses, SC Engagement expenses, SC meeting expenses and the purchase of duke cares gift cards.

The balance in the Alterna Savings account is \$28,323.09 with several items to be purchased in the upcoming months.

Motion/Vote: Passed unanimously \$1400 to pay for the additional 92 students for the sewing initiative (splitting cost 80/20 with School Council/School budgets)

Community Discussion (Chair) TDSB Budget, Duke Staffing Impacts

Overview of the TDSB Budget process currently underway - looked at the TDSB website and <u>resources available</u> (key reports Revenue & Expenditure Trends 2024 & Options to Balance the Budget - pg 24 Summary of unfunded expenses, pg 25 totals for how to balance budget).

Anyone can make a delegation at any TDSB meeting (discussed process). Jenn H is delegating March 26 re: funding for education. Shared 160 people have registered to make delegations.

Budget Highlights:

- There are a series of FBEC meetings this week with Trustees
- Apr 2 Whole committee budget vote
- Projecting a \$35M deficit must do cuts to balance
- Must have a balanced budget by June 30 required
- Waiting for GSN (Grant for Student Needs) amount to be announced
- 65% budget Staffing, 85% Staffing plus benefits
- Everything is driven by student enrolment for funding
- In year 2 of 3 year Deficit Recovery Plan
- Still waiting outcome of the Value for Money Audit by the Auditor General
- To save costs will download some expenses to the school level (e.g. Grade 9 computer costs, outdoor education travel expenses
- Implementing sliding scale of fees for outdoor education trips tied to LOI
- 20 VPs cut (not at Duke) motion to put them back into the budget unlikely Duke would get another VP unless enrollment increases

Staffing at Duke

- Stable for next year
- Keeping Safety Monitor
- Getting an additional Lunchroom Supervisor
- Losing .5 Resource (this year 2.5, next year 2.0)
- Waiting to hear for SNA (Special Needs Assistant) allocation

Discussion around advocacy for funding for education

Principals' Report (Bill Vatzolas, Delphine Rule)

- Working on the Staffing model for 2024/25 school year, explained steps
- Next meeting will share the classroom model
- TDSB has given them staffing levels will be 40 teachers, 33 homerooms have allocation for library
- Apr 16 Grad Photo Day
- May 3 Gr 7 second vaccine
- Musical Apr 30, May 1, 2 everyone working hard, it's all coming together
- Pool have hired a person start Apr 2, stay until end of year. Schedule will return to the usual swim day, info will be communicated.
- Construction had a meeting with Engineer, etc. There is an issue with the project additional complexity, may extend/delay completion
- Landscape wooden fence, basketball court repaving, grading, rocks/tree coming soon
