Say goodbye to the slog of everyday life, homeschooling and supermarket shopping at 20 paces and hello to kick back coastal bliss in the countries finest seaside town.

As always, our team of housekeepers, chefs and hospitality service providers will be on hand to provide the very highest standards of service to you and your family should you need them to make this a truly special break in 2022. Due to the nature of the service industry this year services are limited, booking up fast and will be subject to availability. Where possible we will endeavour to accommodate last minute requests. Below is everything 'new' that you should need to know including;

Please note 2 main requests from housekeeping

- 1. To strip beds on departure;
- 2. An adjustment to check in/out times 3pm and 11am respectfully.

Our aim is to help make your stay as enjoyable as possible.

Cleaning

- Guests are kindly asked to strip all bedding, not protector covers, prior to leaving and place all linen including tea towels on the hallway bench
- Check-in 3pm**
- · Check-out 11am, including cars removed from allocated parking, unless arranged in advance.
- Please leave the BBQ clean and tidy
- Please note failure to clean the BBQ will incur a £50 charge.
- Please use recycle bins where possible. Bins can be found on the terrace and recycling is collected every Friday in bags from the front gate to Devon Road.

Well hasn't cleaning been a big debate? I have primed and bribed our housekeeper and cleaning staff to within an inch of my life with PPE, virus training gadgets and goodies galore and finally persuaded them to do same day cleaning and linen, unlike many of the local operators. I have even twisted her arm to allow the usual **check-out time at 11am** instead of the Salcombe wide 9am (who on earth would be ready to leave at 9am I ask? Perhaps there is a rare breed out there but not me). The team have agreed. **Whilst check is 3pm**, guest may park their car in the allocated parking bays from 1pm on the day of arrival. For the safety of our staff please do not enter the property early to drop bags off.

Additional time has been allocated to cleaning this year to provide safer accommodation for our guests and thus the adjustment to changeover times.

Stripping the beds allows our staff to avoid the direct contact with bedding and is really their only major request so we send our thanks in advance for your cooperation on this matter¹.

Please be reassured that the house will be thoroughly cleaned prior to your arrival. Our reviews on cleaning have always been superb for both The Booty and Merchants House and we aim to

continue this level of service as usual. Please note. Only cleaning products provided in the house should be used². We have a variety of fine and delicate surfaces which we feel takes our home from being an average holiday rental to a luxury experience more like a home from home. These include to name a few marble, stone, nickel and antique furniture, fixtures and fittings which will not take kindly to products containing bleach or strong acidic/ammonia based ingredients, let alone a ring of vintage rum or red wine. Surface protectors, trivets and coasters are provided in abundance for your convenience. A bottle of antibacterial/anti viral spray and hospital grade hand sanitiser will be provided on your arrival in the house along with antibacterial hand soap, and of course the more enjoyable toiletries for the bathrooms. White Company diffusers are also in place this year to erase the scent of cleaning product aromas and bring you back into coastal living harmony.

In line with government guidelines we will be using an antibacterial and anti viral cleaner throughout the property prior to your stay along with antibacterial washing supplements for linens. The best efforts will be put in place to cleanse all surfaces, fixtures and fittings complimented by additional staff training on hygienic and safe practise but we understandably cannot guarantee zero germs left in the building. **Hence your stay is at your risk.** High contact areas such as light switches, door handles, remote controls etc will have added attention.

Safer stays³ have suggested that non-essential items could be removed, but this is not a government guideline. If I were to remove all cushions, throws, books, magazines, toy boxes and ornaments, vases and pictures the house would not offer a home, more an empty cavity. I will be removing the decorative bed throws as these are rarely used in summer anyway and are harder to lauder at short notice. I will not be removing the paintings, nor the cushions, the drift wood ornaments will remain and soft plump cushions will still adorn the sofa after they have been sprayed each changeover with a antiviral fabric specific spray. The toy boxes will be available for children to enjoy and monopoly and more will be available on tap. We have many happy memories of staying in holiday homes in Salcombe and enjoying competitive board games addictive jigsaws and late night card games. I feel this is part of the experience should you want it. If you are concerned about games and toys, as I mentioned above cleaning products are provided and they are mostly in drawers and baskets thus can easily be left untouched, however the guidance from gov.uk on surface contact can be found on the government website.
