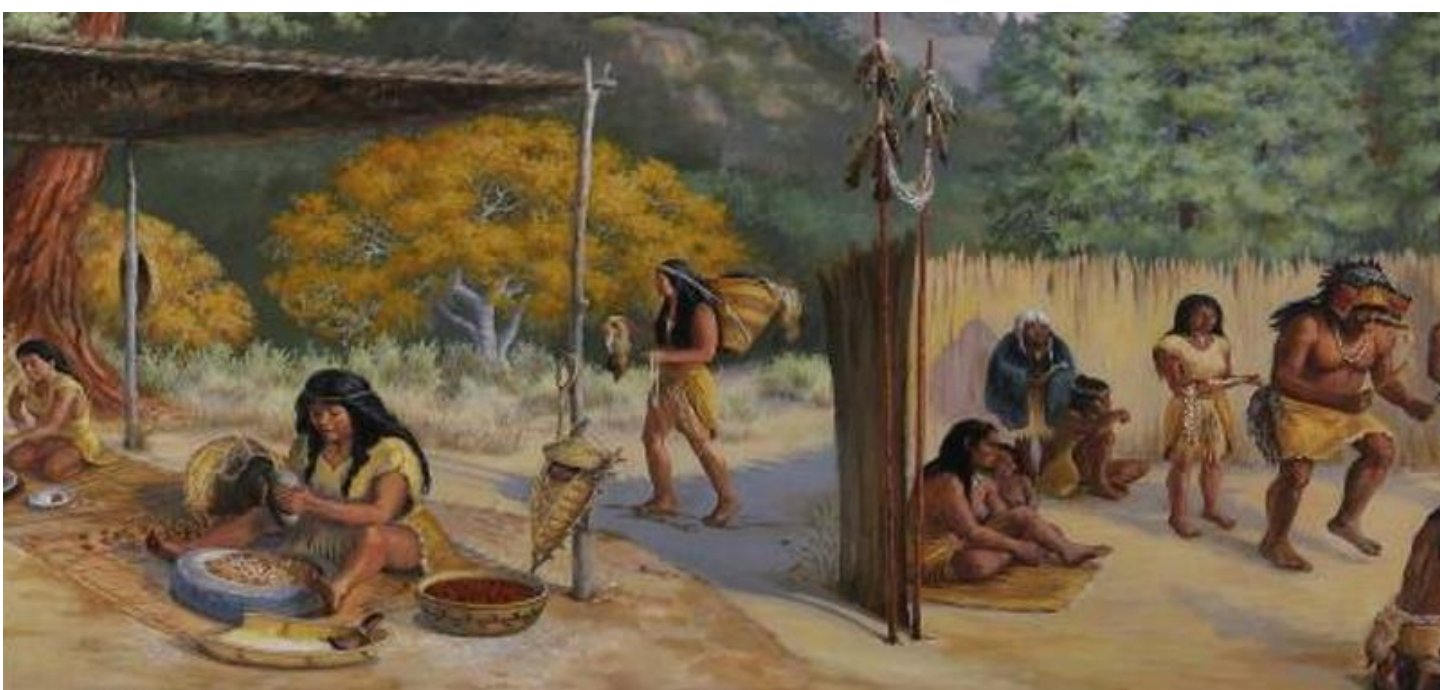


The Pacifica Historical Society Presents...
