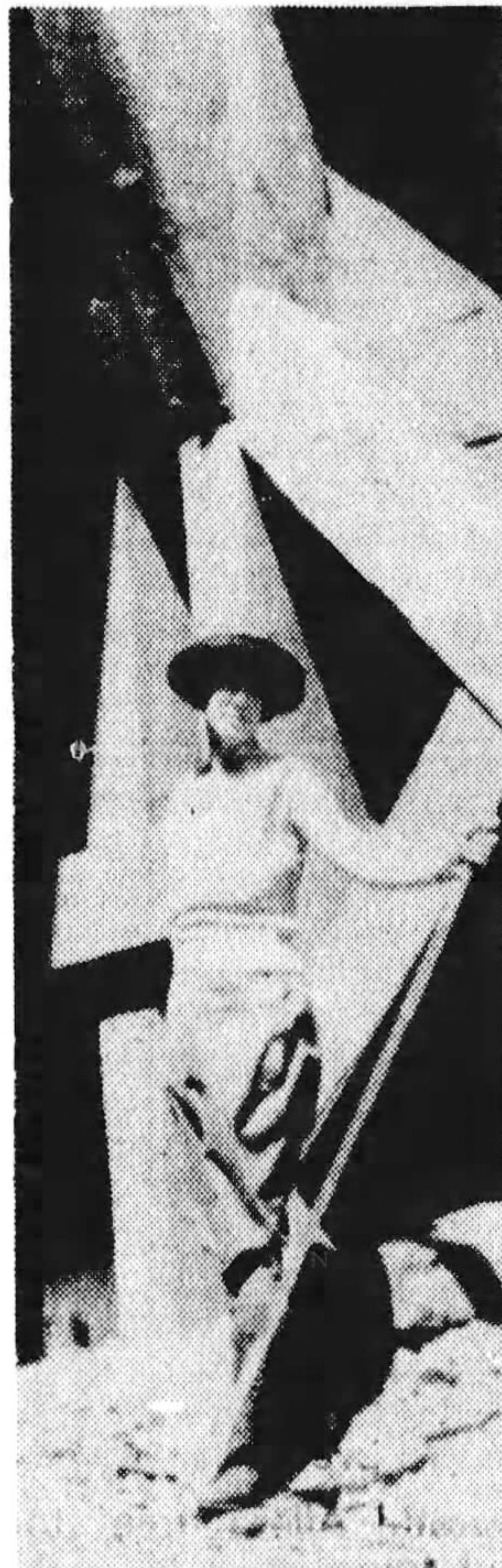




Downtown Rockaway
