

USE OF SVUSD FACILITIES: COVID-19 AMENDMENT (indoor)

The Group/Organization ("User") referenced in this application certifies that the information provided is true and correct. User agrees to strictly observe and enforce all rules and regulations of SVUSD, the principal of the school where the use will occur, as well as those enumerated in the Rules/Regulations in the facility use agreement. The applicant further agrees that the applicant and the responsible officers or representatives of the applicant Group/Organization must, as a condition to this request, save and hold harmless SVUSD for any and all liabilities, including fraudulent and/or groundless accusations of liability, resulting from his/her/their use of school facility.

User is required to be covered by comprehensive general liability insurance. User is responsible for obtaining said insurance and must also present satisfactory proof that such a policy is or will be issued to cover the proposed use if this request is approved. The application will not be approved until satisfactory evidence of insurance naming Sierra Vista Unified School District/SPECIFIC SITE as additional insured is presented in a face amount of not less than \$1,000,000.

User agrees to follow all guidance, rules and regulations as set forth by national, state, local governments and health departments regarding the infection risks and concerns on COVID-19. The user agrees that SVUSD is to be held harmless whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in the contracted user group activity. Additionally, the user agrees to disseminate information to all families, volunteers, and spectators on the risks and organizational efforts being undertaken to mitigate those risks, as outlined below.

➤ The Event

- Maintain appropriate social distancing practices — stay six feet away from individuals; wear a cloth face covering; avoid direct hand or other physical contact.
- Events to be performed without an intermission.
- Following CDC mass gathering guidelines, events may need to :
 - Add additional performances to accommodate limited attendance at each
 - Be held virtually

➤ The Audience

- Seating must adhere to best physical distancing of at least six feet when possible
 - Consider reserved seating that insures spaced seating for attendees who are not in the same party.
 - Consider alternate rows and sections
- Clear attendance guidelines for attending patrons
 - Stay home if sick.
 - Face masks required for reducing risk of infection for self and others.
 - Observe physical distancing guidelines (6' from other guests)
- Promote healthy hygiene practices
 - Do not touch eyes, nose, or mouth
 - Covering coughs/sneezes with tissue or elbow
 - Use hand sanitizer and/or wash hands after leaving public spaces.
- High risk individuals for severe illness, adults 65 or older, or those of any age with underlying medical conditions should avoid large gatherings.
- Onsite response/assessment required for any with observed/self-reported symptoms.

➤ The Performers

- Limit large performance groups – spacing performers six feet apart where possible.
- Provide appropriate PPE for performers in the stage and backstage areas.
- Limit or eliminate sharing of hand props, set props, and costumes.
- Hygiene and physical distancing plan for backstage dressing, changing and restroom facilities.
