The primary colours are red, yellow, and blue. These colours can be mixed together to make other different colours.

Mixing two primary colours makes a secondary colour. The secondary colours are orange, green, and violet (purple).

Orange is made by mixing yellow and red. Green is made by mixing yellow and blue. Violet is made by mixing red and blue.

Intermediate colours can be made by mixing a primary and a secondary colour together. Some intermediate colours are blue–violet and red–orange. Black, white, and grey are special colours. They are called neutral colours.

Colours can be organized into a colour wheel. A colour wheel shows the three primary colours, the three secondary colours, and the six intermediate colours. Artists and designers often use a colour wheel. It helps them to decide which colours they want to use together.
