Off My Onions!

- Onions belong to the lily family. The fleshy, white part of the onion, which grows under the ground and which we use for cooking and salads, are actually leaves. These are specially designed leaves, used to store food for the plant. The stem is actually the round part found at the base of the onion.
- There are over a hundred varieties of onions. The common ones in India are the pink, white and small sambhar or pearl onions. In the West, yellow onions are popular. Shallots, which are sweeter, are also regularly used.



- 3. Onions usually grow under the soil, where the bulb thickens and matures and is harvested. But in some varieties, tiny bunches on onions grow on top of the plant, where you'd usually see the flowers. These are called tree onions or walking onions.
- 4. Onions are eaten in a numerous ways—cooked, raw as salad, in curries, pastes etc. The young bulbs with green shoots are the famous spring onions. Even onion seeds, which are black in colour, are used for flavouring naan breads.
- When onions are cut, they release a pungent compound that enters our eyes and makes them water.
- 6. To prevent this, cut onions in half and keep them under water for some time. Then chop. Or, keep a lit candle near you. The flame absorbs the compound and you won't cry.
