Q. What is required to be a Triple Thread Learning Franchisee?

A. Triple Thread Learning Franchisees must be passionate, dedicated and open minded about learning and building relationships to help people with specialised learning difficulties.

Our Franchisees must be Australian Citizens or hold a valid working visa in Australia and all applicants are required to be tertiary qualified in education and demonstrate relevant work experience in the education and teaching industry.

Franchisees undertake the 2 year TTL Professional Pathway and all external training including the IMSLE course and certification. They must obtain all relevant accreditation including working with children checks, first aid, child protection and any other relevant documents for working as external providers in schools.

Our franchisees will be dynamic and enthusiastic, have excellent written and verbal communication skills, have a good working knowledge of technology in education and be able to form professional relationships with their clients, parents and teachers. Franchisees will work on their own, under supervision and as a part of a larger network.

Would a TTL Franchise suit me?

Triple Thread Learning Franchisees are designed to suit either primary or high school teachers who have a keen interest in structured literacy and who would like to work with people starting at 4 years of age up to adults. This is an opportunity to make a difference to the lives of people who are hard to reach in the mainstream classroom environment or have not received the most effective intervention.

Our industry and business model appeals specifically to teachers who would like to specialise in a specific field of learning and/or are looking at a career change with flexibility and control over their work schedule.
