- ★ Collecting class money and keeping receipts (which will be discussed at the Meet-and-Greet).
- ★ Emailing PTA reminders to your class.
- ★ Attending PTA meetings to stay informed and to give feedback.

Additionally, You Must:

- Be a **paid** member in the current year of the PTA. (*Registration begins July 1st. Those who do not register will not be considered.*)
- Volunteer for at least one other PTA event during the school year, *whether it be holding a spot on a committee or volunteering for an event, like book fair or field day.*
