Emergency Medical Technician Program

Are you interested in becoming a licensed emergency medical technician? The St. Charles EMT Training Program, which also prepares participants for state and national licensing exams, provides the foundational training for emergency care providers. Through classroom instruction, practical skill development, and clinical observation in an ambulance and hospital emergency room, students will gain a foundational understanding of emergency care techniques. Students who complete this

program are eligible to take the National Registry Exam (NREMT), which is necessary for Missouri certification.

PLEASE NOTE: Prospective students must attend a mandatory orientation to obtain the requirements for the program and pass the entrance exam to enroll. You must be 18 or older and provide proof of a high school diploma, GED/ HISET, or college transcript. A Missouri criminal background check is required for all incoming students. (No class: 11/27)

MEDICAL BILLING & CODING



Certified Billing & Coding Specialist

Prerequisite: Basic Computer Skills

The St. Charles Billing and Coding Specialist program will provide the information and training you need to earn a certified CBCS (Certified Billing and Coding Specialist) certificate.

This 14-week comprehensive course consists of 84 hours of classroom instruction. You will learn the foundations of medical terminology and the technical knowledge and skills to maintain aspects of the revenue cycle to ensure reimbursements are completed on time. This course will prepare you for how to gather, review, and verify essential patient information and documentation, how to prevent fraud and abuse by auditing billing, how to assign numeric codes for diagnoses and procedures, and how to coach healthcare providers to achieve optimal reimbursement when submitting claims.

Upon completing the course, you will take the CBCS exam provided by the National Healthcareer Association (NHA).

Heating and Air Conditioning Technology

This course introduces the core principles of refrigeration, heat transfer, and residential HVAC systems. Students will learn how to:

- Understand and apply basic heat and refrigeration theory
- Read wiring schematics
- Test, diagnose, and service residential air conditioning units
- Work with automatic and electrical controls, including electric heat, gas furnaces, and heat pumps

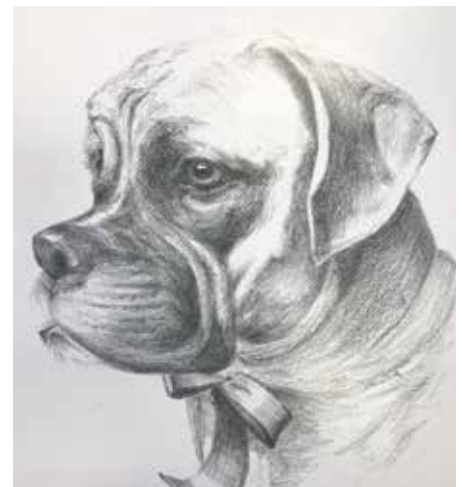
