EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN PROGRAM

Are you interested in becoming a licensed emergency medical technician? The St. Charles EMT Training Program, which also prepares participants for state and national licensing exams, provides the foundational training for emergency care providers. Through classroom instruction, practical skill development, and clinical observation in an ambulance and hospital emergency room, students will gain a foundational understanding of emergency care techniques. Students who complete this program are eligible to take the National Registry Exam (NREMT), which is necessary for Missouri certification.

PLEASE NOTE: Prospective students must attend a mandatory orientation to obtain the requirements for the program and pass the entrance exam to enroll. You must be 18 or older and provide proof of a high school diploma, GED/ HISET, or college transcript. A Missouri criminal background check is required for all incoming students.

REFUND POLICY: For courses lasting less than eight weeks, you must notify the ACE office at least two full business days before the class start date to receive a refund. A \$10 cancellation fee will be applied. If you elect to keep your funds on account for future use, the \$10 cancellation fee will be waived. If the request is received less than two full business days before the start of class, no refunds, transfers, or credits will be issued.

For courses over eight weeks, a non-refundable registration fee applies. If you elect to cancel the course, you must notify the ACE office to receive a refund of the remaining balance. If the request is received less than two full business days before the start of class, no refunds, transfers, or credits will be issued.

CHILDREN: Youth under age 16 may attend adult classes only if accompanied by a registered adult and at the discretion of the instructor.

SUPPLIES: Textbooks and materials will be distributed on the first night of class. We cannot guarantee you will receive a textbook on the first night of class if you register less than 48 hours of the class start time. If supplies are required, a supply list will be printed on the invoice or provided by the instructor.
