Emergency Medical Technician Program

Are you interested in becoming a licensed

Emergency Medical Technician? The St. Charles EMT Training Program provides the basic level of training for the emergency care provider and leads to state and national licensure examinations. Students will master basic emergency care skills through classroom training, hands-on skill training, and clinical observation in a hospital emergency

department and an ambulance. Upon completing this program, students are eligible to take the National Registry Exam (NREMT) for certification by the State of Missouri.

PLEASE NOTE: Prospective students must attend a mandatory orientation to obtain the requirements for the program and pass the entrance exam to enroll. You must be 18 or older and provide proof of a high school diploma, GED/ HISET, or college transcript. A Missouri criminal background check is required for all incoming students. (*No class: 11/27*)





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
