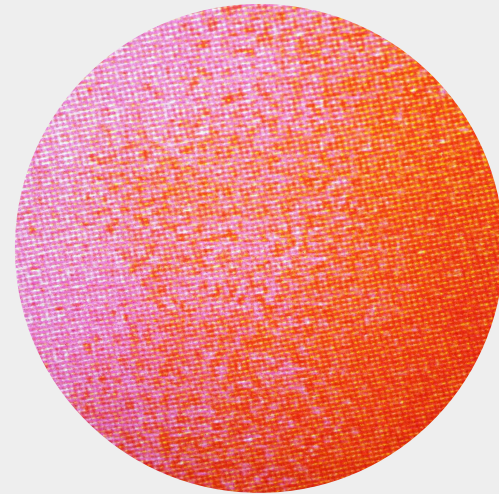
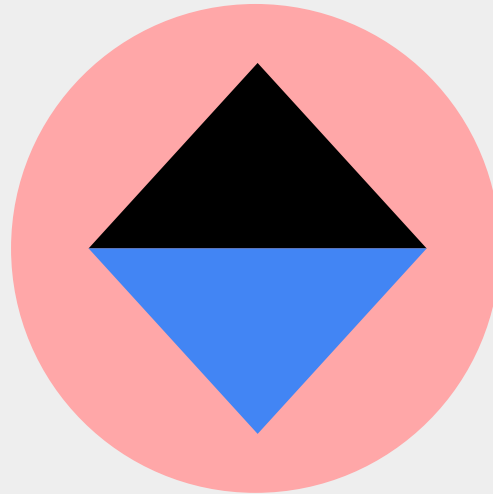
THE PROGRAM

Phenomenal Angels of the Community™ (PAC) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization committed to empowering underserved youth through culturally responsive, trauma-informed programming.

Our mission is to ***provide youth with a cultural, informational, and educational path to individual greatness™*** by offering workshops, activities, and opportunities that foster:

- Academic achievement
- Life skills development
- Civic engagement
- Cultural enrichment
- Leadership and empowerment

We primarily serve middle and high school youth in South Los Angeles and surrounding communities.

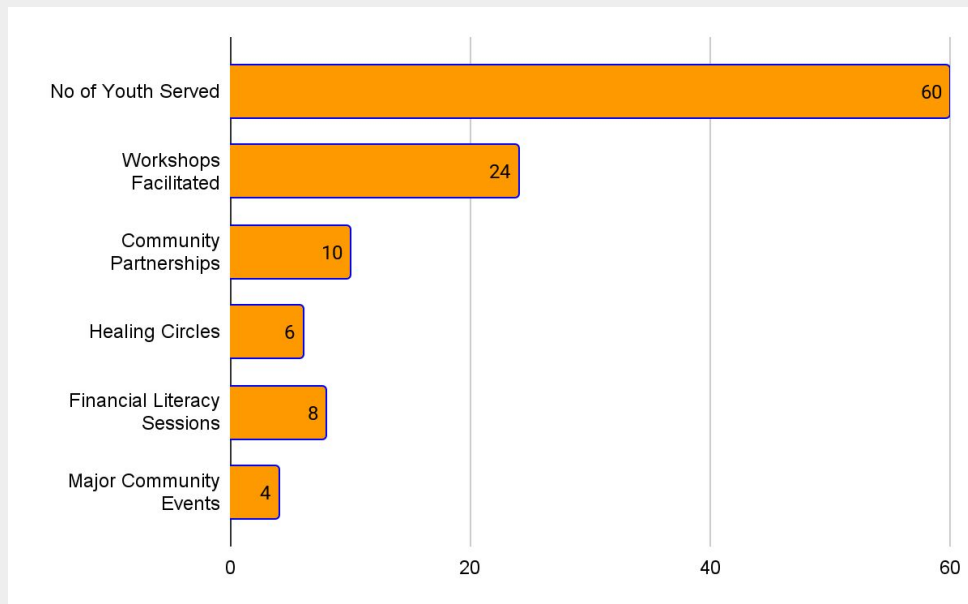




2025 AT A GLANCE

Phenomenal Angels of the Community™ served **over 60 youth** through workshops focused on life skills. **Facilitated 24** leadership and personal development workshops.

We distributed **more than \$12,000** in youth stipends and incentives to encourage participation and reward engagement, **hosted 6 healing circles** to support youth wellness, emotional growth, and peer connection, **conducted 8 financial literacy** sessions to build money management and workforce readiness skills, and **held 4 major community events** that strengthened community ties and provided meaningful engagement opportunities for youth and families.

Youth participated in ***healing circles and prevention workshops*** that promoted conflict resolution, emotional wellness, and resilience, helping to reduce violence and build safer communities.

Youth gained essential ***money management skills*** through interactive workshops preparing them for long-term financial independence.

Youth participated in empowering sessions that promoted ***confidence***, positive self-image, and self-worth, helping them build resilience and embrace their identity.

Youth engaged in service ***projects and community*** activities that fostered leadership, social responsibility, and a deeper connection to their communities.





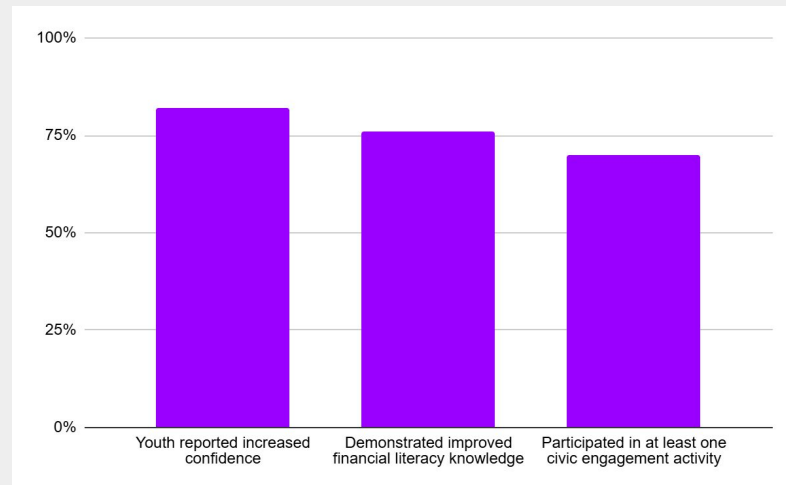
OUTCOMES AND MEASUREMENTS

In 2025:

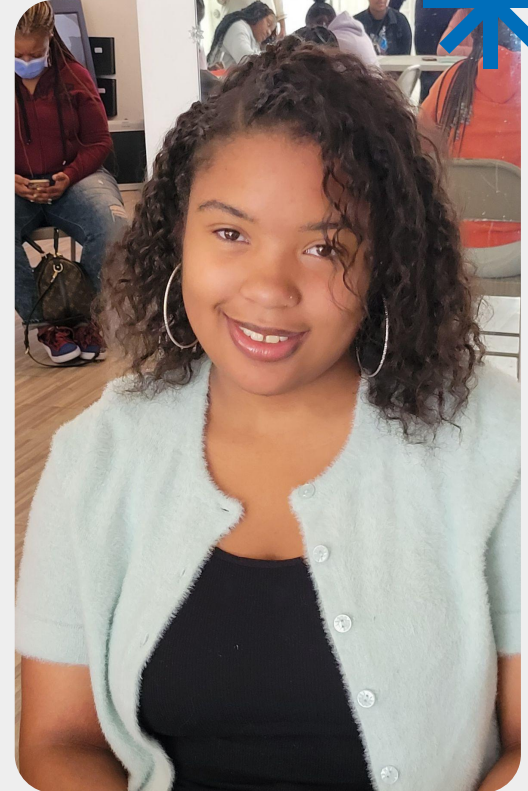
- 82% of youth reported **increased** confidence
- 76% demonstrated **improved** financial literacy knowledge
- 70% **participated** in at least one civic engagement activity

Through consistent participation in healing circles and financial literacy workshops, I improved my attendance, opened my first savings account, and became a peer leader. 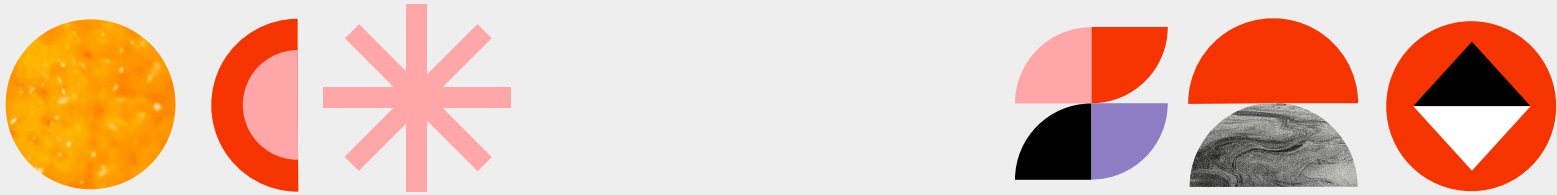
COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS



We collaborate with local violence prevention organizations, financial institutions, law enforcement agencies, and community leaders to ensure youth receive wraparound support and meaningful opportunities.

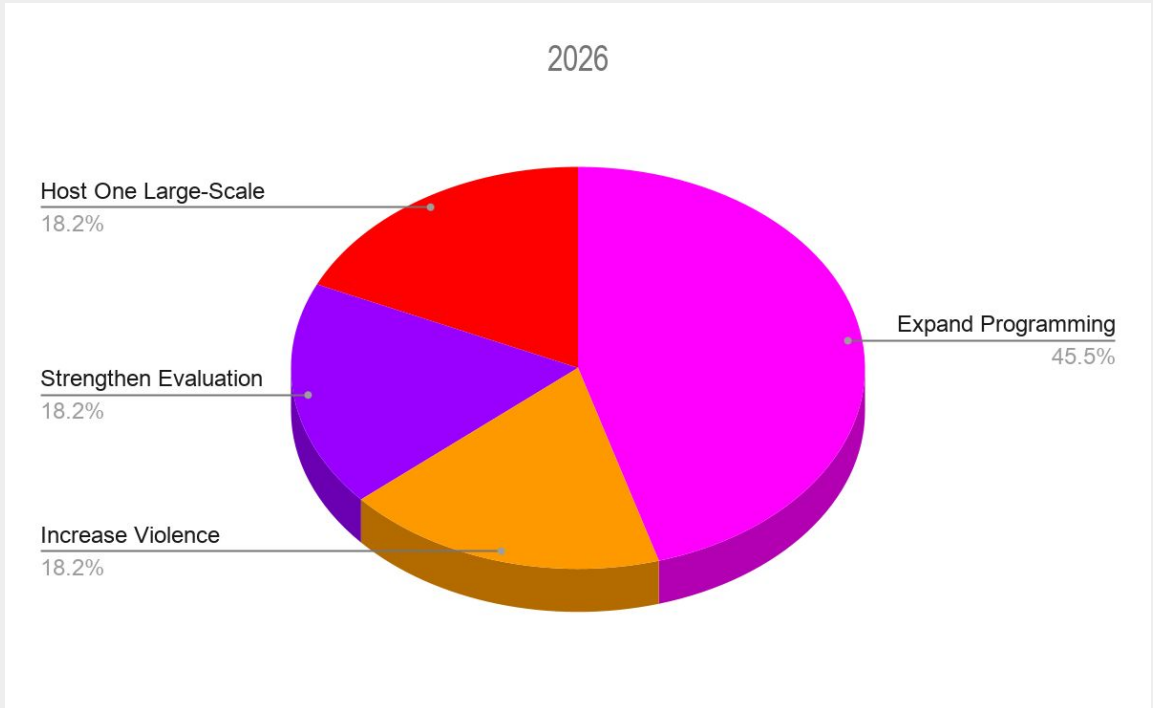

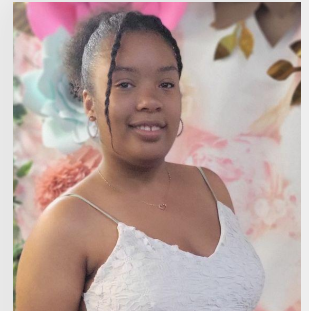

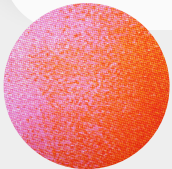
