About Us



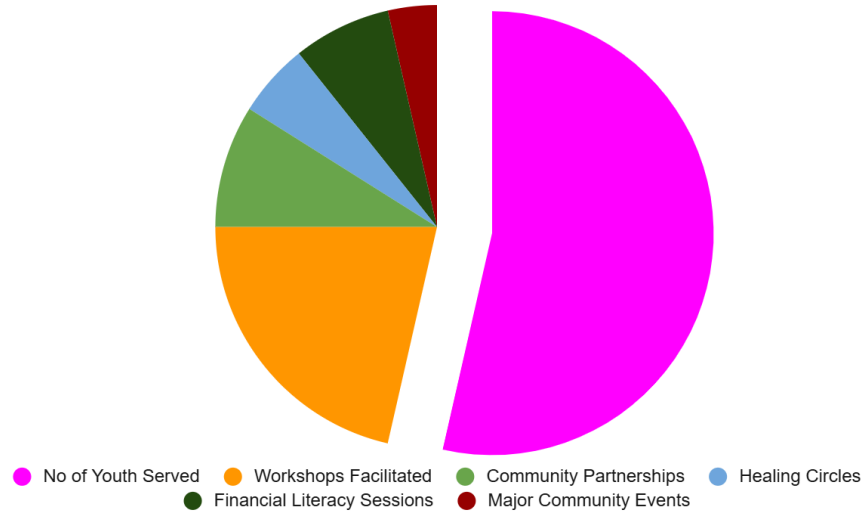

We primarily serve middle and high school youth in South Los Angeles and surrounding communities.

Youth Impact Story

One participant entered the program struggling with school attendance and peer conflict. Through consistent participation in healing circles and financial literacy workshops, she improved her attendance, opened her first savings account, and became a peer leader. By the end of the year, she helped facilitate a workshop for younger participants — demonstrating growth in confidence, responsibility, and leadership.

Community Partnerships

We collaborate with local violence prevention organizations, financial institutions, and community leaders to ensure youth receive wraparound support and meaningful opportunities.

Outcomes & Measurement

We track success through:

- Post-program surveys
- Attendance tracking
- Behavioral improvement indicators
- Youth leadership participation
- Workshop completion rates

In 2025:

- 82% of youth reported increased confidence
- 76% demonstrated improved financial literacy knowledge
- 70% participated in at least one civic engagement activity
