Rules and responsibilities while staying on resort property.

- 1 Payment must be received in full to guarantee your RV site.
- 2 All guests must check in with management upon arrival.
- 3 Your RV site will be assigned upon your reservation request and payment (subject to change if deemed necessary). If you would like to be next to someone, please designate it on your reservation form.
- 4 No parking is allowed in the street. Please do not park in any empty site or common areas.
- 5 Please observe the 5 MPH speed limit at all times.

Anyone operating a motorized vehicle on the resort property must have a valid Driver's License.

- 6 Quiet time is 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Please remember that your neighbor may be trying to sleep. Rowdiness loud music, abusive language, drunkenness, and possession or use of drugs is strictly prohibited.
- 7 All pets must be contained or restrained on a leash of no more than 6 feet at all times. Droppings and any waste material from pets must be picked up immediately and removed to trash containers.
- 8 Please keep the area around your unit neat and clean. Please keep outside storage of items to a minimum.
- 9 **NO ground fires are allowed.** Grills cannot be used for open fires. Fires must be contained in an above ground outdoor enclosed fire pit.
- 10 Waste/sewage, water or effluent from sinks or other plumbing fixtures must be deposited in the holding tank located on your RV site. Nothing can be deposited directly on any pavement, dirt or vegetation.
- 11 Sites are designed for approved recreational vehicles only. No tent camping on the grounds will be allowed.
- 12 Parents are responsible for the whereabouts, safety and conduct of their children at all times. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- 13 All signs, posted notices and directions of the RV Resort Management must be obeyed. Non compliance may result in immediate loss of parking privileges.
- 14 Respect the property of all neighbors of the Resort property. Do not trespass on their land.
- 15 All federal, state and local laws must be obeyed at all times.
- 16 Shell Harbour RV Resort reserves the right to refuse service or evict anyone in violation of these RV Resort Policies of good camping, for destroying, or defacing property and/or creating a disturbance.
