



A most useful solar powered charging station and battery was donated by Fred and installed by Fred & Godwin for convenient on field battery charging. It is working well and getting plenty of use.

The future of the new field is still in discussion with Latrobe City Council. Personally, I do not think we will be moving any time soon

On a promising note, however, we have several new younger members who are experienced pilots and I have enjoyed watching their skills in the air.

Overall, the tone of the Club is one of cooperation and good humour which shows that the Club is in a good position moving forward. Finally, in closing I would like to thank Wayne, Godwin, Chris and the subcommittee for their support during the past year.

### 7.2 Secretaries Report : Secretaries Report 2023-2024 :

It has been another pretty good year for the club. Membership for the 23-24 year ended on 50 members, which was 4 up on the previous year in which we had 46 members. Current financial membership for 24-25 year is 41 with a few members still to become financial. Graeme Blackman has indicated that he will not be re-joining this year as he has moved to Geelong and is flying with the South Coast Flyers.

The MAAA introduced a new registration system in 22-23 and we now are able to print our own MAAA Membership Cards. The Secretary is able to print the card for anyone that cannot do it themselves. The MAAA "Jungle" program has had several delays and is now being implemented into some Clubs. It is expected that by the end of this year all Clubs will be using "Jungle".

We have had some very windy days during the warmer months and several flydays & events had to be postponed but we still managed to have several successful Club fly days and events throughout the year. Unfortunately, the CCMT was started but has not been finished except for John Gillam who has completed the events. There will be some discussion on the CCMT in General Business.

We had the Swinburne Air Hub using our field on several occasions in 2024, flying and experimenting with some large Drones, one using Hydrogen as the fuel. We did decide to ask for a donation to the Club of \$50 per day, \$25 if they cancel. An Invoice has been sent but at this stage no funds have been received. Latrobe City Council is hoping something will come of these experiments that will benefit the Community and currently some sort of Drone building enterprise is taking shape at the Latrobe Regional Airport.

The Latrobe City Council have found a site at Toners Lane in Morwell that they hope to obtain from Energy Australia but many of us have doubts about the site. I think it will be ok for smaller electric models but not for Petrol & Nitro, mainly because of the noise. It would probably be at least 6 years away if it happens.

The surveyors have been along the roadway into Lake Narracan and marked out the sewerage line route and this will have an impact on our site. The line zigzags across the track in so we will need entry from the Hayes Rd end to continue flying. No time line at present on this.

Our Club Social Christmas Lunch at the Moe RSL was well attended and unfortunately our Mid year Lunch was not well attended, possibly to the current cost of living issues. Unfortunately, we haven't had many sausage sizzle flydays due to the weather, which can only improve.

I would like to thank everyone that has assisted me in this job for this year and I look forward to another year in the Hot Seat.


