The President opened the meeting at 6:35 p.m.

**I. Finance:**

As of March 31, 2022, we currently have \$7,595.60 in the bank and \$6,800 that still needs to be transferred over. Expenses so far this year have been for Spring football uniforms and helmets and concession stand items.

**II. Cheer:**

Cheer camp is schedule for April 23, 2022, at 1:30 – 5:30 at a location to be determined. There are currently 19 girls registered for camp and we still need to collect outstanding registration fees. There is some concern with the \$16.00 membership fee. Parents will be directed to the AAU website to pay the fee. We are hoping to provide parents with a direct link to pay the membership fee.

Shantai would like to open Cheer Fall Registration as soon as possible so that the uniforms can be ordered in a timely fashion. She is hoping to schedule the fitting for uniforms the first of May. Demetrius has requested the roster for the girls to turn in to Manor ISD to reserve a field for the Cheer Camp. The roster must be turned in 10 days before the event.

**III. Football:**

Registration for the Spring season is now closed. We have enough children for two Pee Wee Teams; one Rookie Team; one Junior Team; one Senior Team; and one Varsity Team.

Demetrius also emphasized wanting to start Fall Registration as early as next week. The tentative deadlines for closing registration would be after meeting the 35-roster limit or 6 to 7 weeks before kickoff of first game of the season, July 2, 2022. It is looking like we may meet the 35 -roster limit with the Rookie and Junior Teams.

Demetrius also stated that we have tentative dates of April 23<sup>rd</sup> and May 7<sup>th</sup> to host during Spring season. This will give us an opportunity to raise funds at the concession stand. Football games are scheduled for 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. There may be a conflict with the April 23<sup>rd</sup> schedule due to Cheer Camp. Shantai offered to see if she could reserve Metropolitan Park as an alternative.

Coaches and Certification:

Most of our coaches are already certified. The children will need to be certified an hour before each game. The cert cards and waiver will be required. Coaches bring your books with you.

Concessions and Bathroom:

We will need volunteers to always sign up and at least one board member at the concession stand to oversee the money.

There will be an AAU Presidents meeting held in Killeen on May 1, 2022. Those in attendance will share information with the board to help us plan for the Fall season.

**Events Coordinator:**

Danielle states she will be knocking on doors for sponsorships and shopping locally to see what can be made to give to our sponsors in their tier group of donations. She would also like to start the Calendar event early this year. We also have an opportunity to work the high school game concessions and bring in up to \$5,000 in a split profit. She indicated that we need at least 10 people to sign up to make this possible.

The meeting closed at 7:00 p.m. The next meeting and location are to be determined.
