

MAYA Board Meeting Minutes
May 16, 2021

I. Opening

The President opened the meeting at 6:23 p.m. and distributed the meeting agenda.

II. Website

Manorayamustangs.net. Please peruse at the website and offer your suggestions. Jeremy Sheard will be given access to the following: Manorayamustangs.net, Sports Engine and our Facebook page as an administrator. Registration will also be available through this site until Sports Engine is up and running for Fall registration.

Sports Engine is not available at this time, but once it is up and running all registration documents can be uploaded and payments can be made. We can also complete certification through this site.

III. Fall Registration

Early registration for football is now open and runs through July 16th. The cost for early registration is \$180/Flag and \$200/Tackle. Late registration runs from July 17th through July 31st and the cost is \$210/Flag Football and \$230/Tackle. If a payment plan is required, the final payment must be paid by July 31st. These dates are firm and non-negotiable. Also, it has been determined that we need to stop offering additional discounts and selling equipment at cost as ways to keep more money in the organization and not give it away.

CTYFL registration cost will be \$80-\$87 per organization this year. They are also allowing us to use any government issued ID this year i.e., passport, birth certificate, ID cards. There is a protocol that must be followed for headshots (no glamour shots or hats and caps).

A flyer for Fall registration was shared with the board as an example of advertising this season. Everyone agreed and just wanted to be sure we let everyone know that equipment (helmet and pads) is not included in the fees to avoid any misunderstanding. We will also need to post signs.

IV. Walkup Registration/Dates

The president will speak with Libation Station and see if we can setup there. The tentative date for walkup registration is tentatively June 5th. The location is to be determined. The Sheards also suggested that we ask Shadow Glen (contact: Edward) and other surrounding communities if we could use their club house. It was also stated that we might want to get permission from the

schools in Manor. Demetrius volunteered to be available to setup registration right after school at each location on a rotating schedule.

Shantai and Robin have agreed to setup registration at during our current practice on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. All registration information should be posted on our website.

Registration for AAU will be in a separate packet and will not be included on the website. August 1st is the deadline for certification for AAU. The organization will be verifying our books on August 15th.

V. Finances

I did not have much to offer about our finances with the exception that this season registration was a success. We have collected all funds for Spring football. I also presented our April spreadsheet for review. After registration and expenses, we still have \$1055.30 in our account.

VI. Cheer

Registration for cheer is now open. Registration fees are \$300/for new cheerleaders and \$150/for returning cheerleaders. The difference in price is uniforms will have to be ordered for new cheerleaders.

There is an upcoming Cheer Camp scheduled for June 27th at the Georgetown Recreation Center from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m. There is a \$30 per participant fee. Shantai will confirm whether board participation is required. Also, Jennifer, CTYFL Cheer President has given our group kudos for being active. That is a great boost for our kids and organization.

Cheer was also required to collect \$75.00 in sponsorships by CTYFL. Shantai Bonner provided the fee and sponsored Manor through her Daycare. Thank you Shantai!

VII. Football

CTYFL/AAU will be the parent's choice. CTYFL is a recreation league in our area. AAU is a select league and believed to be more advanced. Cheer will remain with CTYFL, per the Cheer Coordinator. CTYFL will require for referees, AAU will require three referees and one law enforcement officer. AAU will allow us to charge a gate fee for every home game.

We are scheduled for a fitting with Riddell on July 8th for pads and helmets. The pricing has slightly gone up this year. Pads are \$45 and Helmets are \$90. Please have your money to complete your order at the fitting. Please post this information on our site. As mentioned above, the pricing for football is out and registration is now open.

Uniforms: We were presented with two options for uniform design (camo or dye), and we voted 6 to 3 on the camo design. Please be sure to remind parents to order correct sizes for their children or they will be responsible for the fees to order the replacement. We will be ordering the two jersey with duffle bag option.

Football Camp: We are hosting a free football camp starting June 7th through July 2nd, 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. at the Manor High School.

VIII. Fundraising

We are currently raffling a Michael Kors purse and wallet for \$5 a ticket or five for \$20. We would like to have a showcase/pep rally during our football camp and have a drawing for the winner on July 1st. It was also suggested that we sell tumblers and T-Shirts at our concession stand.
