The President opened the meeting at 6:00 p.m.

Finances:

Robin stated we had \$13,600.00 currently in the bank. After she transfers more money, it will be closer to \$20,000.00

Football:

Demetrius chimed in at this point and stated we had enough to pay for all four weeks at the Stadium. He also stated that Swain had some concerns that we would not have the stadium for our first game. Facilities cannot guarantee anything at this time. There will be a school board meeting on August 15th, the costs will be determined at this time. We are at 85% of Manor ISD, so we are not allowed to use it for free.

Referee Fees: Fees have gone up due to gas prices. We will now be paying \$180.00 per game (only for home games).

Certification: Opens on August 13th.

AAU Membership opens up tomorrow – August 1st. Please turn in to Team Managers all rosters of certification of players, coached and cheer.

Hosting home games: The schedule is up to us. We control start times and the order teams will play.

Apparel: James Tinsdale offered to make us \$10.00 Mustang Mafia T-Shirts. Pre-Sale Orders.

We discussed quality of the T-Shirts at length due to past experience.

Fundraisers:

Danielle suggested that we sell raffle tickets for a presentation at Homecoming totaling \$500.00. It will consist of lottery tickets and Gift Cards. There was some feedback about the gambling aspect of the lotto tickets. She also stated so many others were doing the calendars, so we should hold off on that at this time. We also mentioned three drawings: one for the \$500.00, the second would be in the amount of \$250.00 (Grill), and the third for \$100.00 (Mustang Gear). There were other suggestions such as a weekend at Kalahari, a Texas Liquor Chest, and Back-o-School items.

We will issue each player a coupon book of 20 tickets each to sell before homecoming.

We also discussed having a 50/50 raffle at every home game to award the winner at half-time of the 12U game.

Robin was seeking suggestions on how to keep fundraiser revenue separate from the general fund to track it better. She suggested it would be easier to have a separate account.

It was suggested that we could use the money from fundraising to pay all AAU memberships next year, purchase sweatshirts, or participate in unrestricted tournaments.

Danielle also mentioned there was an opportunity to work JV and Varsity game concessions. The Booster Club was offering to let us run it for 25% of the funds as our fee. There will be three windows and we need at least 10 volunteers to keep the lines moving, per their request. We could break it up in two shifts: Open to Half-Time and Half-Time to Close. Please no kids in the concession stand.

Cheer:

Shantai did not have anything specific to offer. She did mention the gentleman who worked the Fish Frye Fundraiser was offering his time to cook hot foods for us. He will volunteer his time and we will need to provide the supplies.

Charlotte also volunteered to do dessert egg rolls.

Security: We are still in need of security guards for the games.

Season Passes: It was suggested that we could offer four entries this season or one entry and a food in the amount of \$12.00.

COVID: You will need to quarantine for 10 days or bring a negative Covid Test.
