The course covers the basics of sailing, including terminology, safety procedures, and fundamental sailing techniques. Participants will learn:

- Parts of a sailboat
- Basic navigation and steering
- Understanding wind direction and sail trim
- Safety on the water
- Emergency procedures and using the radio
- Tacking and jibing

Our Adult Sailing Program is led by a team of experienced RCYC Sailing Mentors who are passionate about sailing and dedicated to teaching. They bring a wealth of knowledge and practical experience to ensure you receive top-notch training. Each instructor is committed to fostering a supportive and engaging learning environment.
