Thank you for your interest in joining the Richmond County Yacht Club ("RCYC"). Richmond County Yacht Club has a fine tradition of yachting, boating, and social activities. Its members are justly proud of their Club and its facilities.

We are pleased and excited that you are applying to become a member of the Richmond County Yacht Club. Your completed application, SIGNED BY BOTH OF YOUR SPONSORS, along with a check for the initiation fee in the amount of \$816.56 (including tax) should be forwarded to the RCYC Office Staff at 142 Mansion Avenue, Staten Island, New York 10308. The initiation fee is 50% (of above) for Associate and not applicable to Junior, Intermediate, Boat Share and Provisional Membership applications.

All applicants are required to have two (2) Corporate Member sponsors complete the enclosed Proposer/Seconder Statements and submit them with the application. Sponsors must both be Corporate Members of the club with at least 2 years of membership. Upon receipt of your completed Application, initiation fee (if applicable), and sponsor forms, you will be contacted by a member of the Membership Committee to arrange a meeting with you and your spouse (if any) where you will be informed of the details of the Club, explore your interest in membership, and get answers to any questions you have concerning membership.

The expenses involved in the application and membership are outlined below.

ANNUAL DUES are based upon class of membership is as follows:

Membership Class	Age Range	Dues Calculation
Regular – (Individual / Joint)	29 and up	\$1,100.00 + 8.875% tax = \$1,197.63
Boat Share (May – October)	21 and Up	\$950.00 + 8.875% tax = \$1,034.31
Associate	30 and Up	50% of Regular Dues = \$550.00 + tax = \$598.81
Provisional	29 and Up	90% of Regular Dues = \$990.00 + tax = \$1,077.86
Intermediate	25 to 29 20 to 24	75% of Regular Dues = \$825.00 + tax = \$898.22 50% of Regular Dues = \$550.00 + tax = \$598.81
Junior	12 to 19	10% of Regular Dues = \$110.00 + tax = \$119.76

ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS

RCYC members voted for the below Annual Assessments:

- Monthly Mortgage Assessment in the amount of \$1,968.36 plus tax per year. With tax, the total annual assessment is \$2,143.08. The Assessment is billed in monthly installments of \$164.03 plus tax; a total of \$178.59.
- Member Loan Assessment in the amount of \$681.60 plus tax per year. With tax the total annual assessment is \$742.08. The Assessment is billed in monthly installments of \$56.80 plus tax; a total of \$61.84.
- Associate members are responsible to pay 50% of the Annual Assessments.
- Junior, Intermediate (24 years of age and under), Boat Share and Provisional members do not pay the Annual Assessments.

ONE TIME FEES

- New members who are neither Junior, Intermediate, Boat Share, nor Provisional members are responsible to pay the following one-time fees upon being admitted to membership:
- Associate members are only responsible for 50% of the Dock Replacement Fund.

Capital Improvement Bond (refundable)	\$400 + tax = \$435.50 (one time upon becoming a member)	
Dock Replacement Fund	\$300 + tax = \$326.63 (one time upon becoming a member)	

The nature and terms of the refund of the Bond will be part of your discussion with the Membership Committee.
