The Archbishop

Final Authority on all Church Matters
(On death or abdication, a new Archbishop will be elected)

The Viceroy

Implementing all orders of the Archbishop
International Communications

The Bishop

Installing Church Orders
Typically overseeing a State or Region

The Pastor

Ministering to his local area
Autonomy over his Church
In keeping with Archbishop's orders
In keeping with the KTC doctrine

The Deacon

To assist his Pastor in Ministry/Church
Discipling new Christians under his Pastor
Other administrative duties

The Commander

(This role is open to men and women)
Recruitment of new Templar Knights and evangelism
Running a KTC Commandery in compliance with local laws

The Templar Knight

All registered members will be recognised as a Knight
All members are the watchmen/women in their location
Every member will adhere to the KTC doctrine
Every Knights Templar will defend the KTC
