What Is Montgomery County MUD No 16?

 Montgomery County MUD No. 16 is a special purpose District with the authority to provide water, sewer, and drainage facilities to support the development of 591 acres of land in Montgomery County, Texas.

Why do we have a MUD?

 Montgomery County MUD No. 16 was created to give unincorporated areas the ability to provide services to residential customers when comparable services are not readily available through local municipal providers.

What Is Bond Authorization?

 Bond authorization is the approval for the District to sell bonds for financing of future projects.

Will this affect my tax rate?

 The District will not sell bonds without input from their financial advisor addressing the tax impact of bond sales.

Will this improve drainage?

 One of the purposes of the bond election is for the voters to approve the District's authority to sell future bonds to fund projects dedicated to storm drainage improvements throughout the District.

What happens if this does not pass?

 The District will be limited in their ability to collect funds for future maintenance and improvements of the water, sewer and drainage facilities.
 If necessary, it could also result in increased monthly water bills.
