Substance Use & Process	- Stored Quantity: 5 litres- Used Quantity: Max 20ml per application- Instructions: Spray neat into car interiors, mist onto carpets for long-lasting effect, avoid over-wetting.- Dilution for Cleaning: 1 part product to 2 parts water. Spray onto cloth and wipe surfaces.
Handling, Storage & Disposal	- Keep away from food and drink.- Keep container sealed when not in use.- Avoid mist formation.- Store in original container, banded trays/cabinets.- Dispose of waste safely via licensed disposal authority.
Accidental Release Measures	- Small spills: Dilute with water and mop up.- Large spills: Absorb with sand/earth, contain, label waste.- Wash contaminated area with water.- Comply with local environmental authority guidelines.
Environmental Considerations	- Product biodegradable per MSDS.- Not classified as dangerous for the environment.- Interceptor tanks used for wash bays.- Banded storage prevents pollution.- No PBT or vPvB substances present.
Existing Control Measures	- COSHH boards displayed in bays.- Colour coding and symbols for easy ID.- PPE available and enforced.- Limited quantities stored/used.- Drains to interceptor tanks.
Occupational Exposure Limit (EH40)	- No known limit from MSDS.- No air monitoring required.
First Aid Measures	- Inhalation: Move to fresh air, keep warm and at rest.- Skin Contact: Remove contaminated clothing, wash with water and soap.- Eye Contact: Rinse eyes thoroughly with water for 10+ minutes.- Ingestion: Rinse mouth, drink water, seek medical help if needed. Do not induce vomiting.
Communication to Employees	- Method statement explained to all staff.- Employees must stop and seek advice before deviating from procedure.- Employee Declaration required (signed).
