



### **President— Mike Slevin**

I have been utilizing the club since 1996 and became a member in 1998. Over the years I have shot at all the ranges, initially when I was younger long-range shooting and pistol were my passion, over time after meeting many of you I picked up shotgun, muzzle loading, and eventually archery (cross bow). Muzzle loading Elk Hunting is my favorite activity, followed by Turkey hunting, but I do a little of everything including fishing and reloading.

In 2010 I started becoming much more active in the club and joined the hunter safety cadre and taught classes at the club as part of that team for 13 years. I also ran the annual NRA sports shoot for 6 years prior to Covid. I served on the board of directors for two terms from 2016 to 2022 and was responsible for club finances during this time.

During my service on the board I worked with many of you on several important issues including; lead contamination and L&I concerns, the accusation that a bullet escaped the range and hit a local school (this was debunked), Entrance road easement and Amazon construction, worked on raising club rates to meet expenses and supported increasing the maintenance of club facilities. Finally, I worked to ensure the club-maintained control of the 113 acres of Tacoma Water property for public ranges through the land foundation where I currently serve as president.

I am a professional engineer with a strong background in environmental and civil engineering; I also have and extensive background with finance. I retired from the City of Tacoma with 28 years, where I served as both the Public Works Director and Environmental Services Director. I am currently working as the Public Works Director for the City of Des Moines. I am also a U.S. Army veteran serving 8 years active duty enlisted, and 20 years as an officer in the Washington National Guard with deployments to Desert Strom, Iraq, and Afghanistan serving as a Master EOD technician and Airborne Sapper Engineer.

Five past presidents have offered their support to my candidacy, and I know of 3 more that would have if they were still with us. If elected I will work diligently to create a strategic business plan for the Club to make sure we are financially stable for years to come while maintaining our conservation mandate as described in the Charter and Bylaws. It is also important that we simultaneously meet the challenges of this States onerous shooting regulations. I also believe we must expand our business model to include the future of shooting sports, such as indoor ranges, and simulated shooting opportunities, as well as modernizing our meeting and gathering spaces.

I hope you find me worthy of your vote and look forward to working with all of you to set this club up for the next 100 years, not since the club moved here from downtown Tacoma has it faced this level of change, I know working together we can meet this challenge.






