Additionally, we have formally engaged real estate representation who are providing a Request for Proposal which we will review and provide to at least three developers to see what kind of value the land holds for the club long term.

3rd Sunday of the month, held in the Action Bays

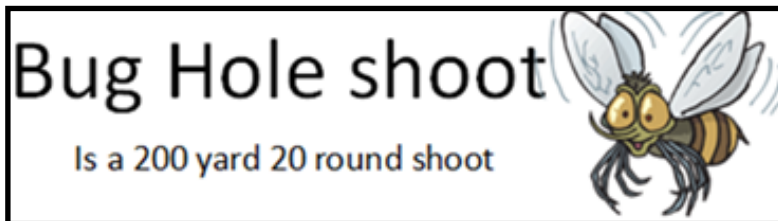
New shooter orientation @ 9am—Match starts @ 10am
