TSC will be making the donation to TSCCLF within the next week to fund the TSCCLF acquisition of the 113 acres from Tacoma Water. The TSCCLF acquisition of the land is tentatively being completed June 27, 2025. This is the property the public ranges, 600 yd range, and archery walk through course are located.
