

The Sportsman

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Hello everyone, hope you all had a great July.

Things have been busy this last month. I have been working on the public pistol and rifle range environmental cleanup. Our data and clean-up plan are in and have been shared with the Department of Ecology. The clean-up will consist of mining the ranges for lead down to 6 inches for the rifle range plus the berms, for the pistol range the berms will be mined and the floor dug out to approximately 7 feet and 3 feet of clean fill will replace the bottom soil. We received 3 bids for the clean-up, and it looks like we will recommend Becker Excavation with a bid price of \$248,000 and a 50/50 split on the lead recovered. The other two bids were AWC at \$241,000 but they had some contractual things we did not concur with, and MT2 for \$407,000 which is too expensive, the board will finalize this at the next meeting. Additionally, we will have \$60,000 in costs for environmental monitoring, construction reporting, and the final remediation report for Ecology. This brings total cost of cleanup \$308,000, plus the \$62,000 already spent for the Environmental testing and Clean Up Action report. Currently we are waiting on a Pierce County excavation permit before we can go forward with physical work if approved by the board.

We have also been busy with the Land Committee; a Request for Proposal has been released to 3 qualified developers to get a better understanding of what the market can bring if the Club decides to sell a portion of the 80 acres we own in fee. The RFP informs the developers that we would seek to retain approximately 20 acres, but where those are, is negotiable. We would also want to maintain access off Military Road, and access to the 113 acres of leased foundation land. Finally, we have let them know we would be interested in a 30-40,000 sq ft building that would be built to suit by the development team. We have scheduled September 26th as the day to hear all three proposals.

Finally hope everyone is getting to out to go fishing this summer, perhaps the shotgunners have enjoyed the revival of Sporting Clays, and I hope those that could attend had a great time at the TSC Picnic.

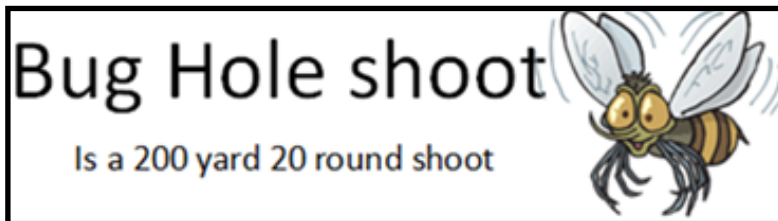
