Due to recent updates to the *private club* liquor service rules, the WSLCB *requires* the following rules in order to provide liquor at any private club:

- The Bar may not be open to the "public"
- Excludes prearranged membership drives
- Any event marketing/advertising may not be directed to the public (social media, reader board, etc.)
- Liquor may only be serve to Members or Invited visitors of members attending an event (additional conditions apply)
- TSC may not sponsor (budget, pay for, donate to) BYOB events
- **→** If the Bar is open during an event where the public is in attendance:
- ⇒ Minors (under 21) may not be in foyer (This condition may be updated pending a license modification)
- ⇒ Alcohol not permitted in places where minors are present (i.e. Hall)
- Outside alcohol is not permitted

UPDATED Bar Rules:

- Members MUST *present* your badge for a \$1 Discount
- Visitors with Members MUST be signed in by the member or no alcohol may be served
- No Overservice permitted
- No firearms at or behind the bar





Classes: Centerfire, Rimfire, Revolver, PCC, Optics


Each match will be 4stages with 5 steel plates, shot 4 consecutive times per stage (subject to change)
