





Competition consists of confirmation shot(s), unlimited sight in, and 10 record shots.

Record shots performed in five shot strings in 5 min with cool down period in between.

Monetary prize for shooter with the closes center X. and smallest group.

Standard centerfire rifle calibers accepted, Non-standard calibers subject to review by committee chair and Chief RSO.

A shooter may only shoot a gun once, however more than one shooter may shoot the same gun.

The ideal candidate will have interest in indoor and outdoor janitorial and maintenance tasks and landscaping. This position is perfect for someone currently retired or working part time.

COMPENSATION:

Compensation for this role up to 30 hours per week is a 2-bedroom mobile home on site with water, sewer, garbage included. Cable/Internet will not be included.

Additional hours after 30 but not to exceed 40 will be paid at a rate of \$16.28 per hour.

Daily indoor and outdoor janitorial expectations

Sweep and mop floors and vacuum carpets

Cleans bathrooms, kitchen, foyer, hall, windows, dusts, etc.

Maintain the cleanliness and appearance of the property grounds.

Set up, tear down and cleanup of facilities when used for a function

Ability to provide night watchman tasks, report suspicious activities, trespassing or damage on site

Monitors the use and inventories of maintenance supplies, janitorial supplies and equipment. Initiates reordering when necessary.

Performs additional seasonal tasks both indoor and outdoor
