Once we have the information from them in September the Club can start the debate on how and if we will proceed down this path.

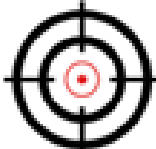
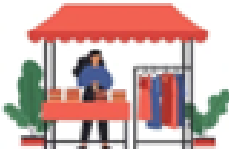

Conservation Land Foundation invasive plant removal project

More than a dozen members and leaders from Local Scout Troop #692 joined a combined work party of TSC and TSC Conservation Land Foundation volunteers June 28 to clear scotch broom on foundation ground. Scotch broom is an invasive species not native to Washington, and the foundation's stewardship plan includes annual work to remove invasive and noxious plants.

Club member Mark Arnold and foundation board members Donn Moyer, Gary Higginbotham, Barb Sher, and Glenn Rodrick led the crew. Mark, Gary, and Donn arrived before the Scouts, cutting stands of large scotch broom and trimming for easier collection. Glenn and Barb along with the Scouts rounded up the cuttings, dragging them to the access road and trimming them before hauling much of the material away.

After four hours of volunteer work, the foundation treated the Scouts to some trigger time, shooting bolt action .22-long-rifle rounds at paper targets on the Piel Range.

The next weekend, TSC members Owen and Bryce Widmer (father-son team) met Donn to gather the rest of the cuttings, then hauled them to the dump.

Scotch broom is prolific and while it's good to put a dent in it, there's still more and future work parties will tackle the remaining invasives. Thanks to all volunteers.

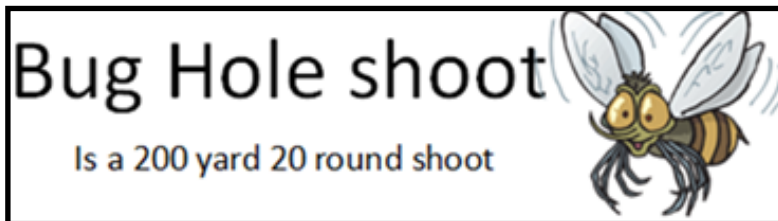
New shooter orientation @ 9am—Match starts @ 10am
