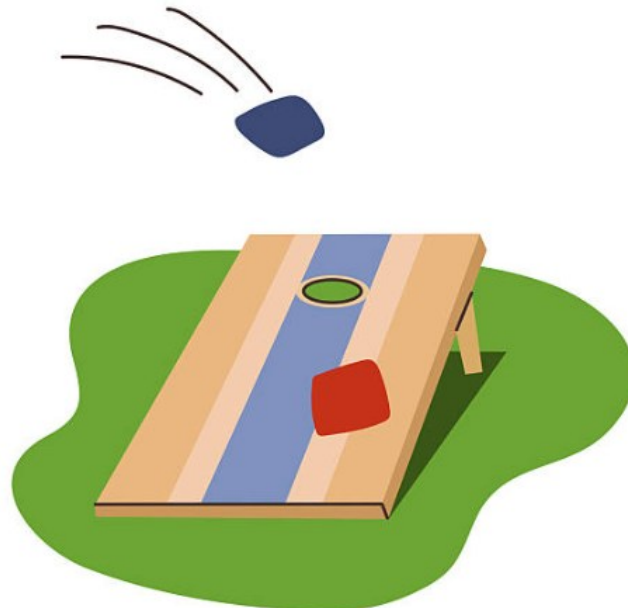
When using any club shooting facilities, **members must wear their membership card in plain view** so CRSOs, RSOs, and ROs can tell members from non-members.

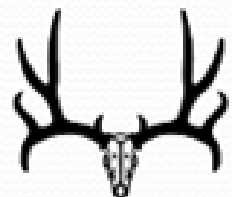
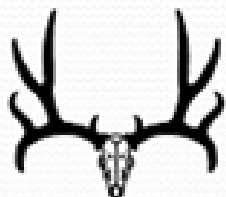
