PISTOL RANGE RULES

- 1. ALL actions must be kept open and unloaded until position is taken on the firing line.
- 2. NO rapid fire.
- 3. Keep that muzzle pointed down range at all times.
- 4. ALL firearms will be laid down, pointed down range or in the rack while people are forward of the firing line.
- 5. NO cans or bottles for targets. Use only existing target frames w/paper targets only.
- 6. NO one under 18 years of age permitted to shoot without adult supervision.
- 7. Parents are responsible for seeing that their children follow range safety rules.
- 8. NO shot shells.
- 9. NO BB guns.
- 10. Muzzleloaders, cap and ball revolvers—keep all sources of powder off the shooting benches.
- 11. Bottleneck rifle cartridges are not permitted.
- 12. Handguns only; NO long guns.
- 13. This range is designed and intended as a target range, not a tactical training range.
- 14. No children under 12 allowed to shoot.

Members and guests must sign in every time they use any of the ranges. This can be done in the office during open hours or at sign-in stations on the ranges.

Ranges are open from 9 am until one half hour before dusk, when they must be vacated.

All ranges are under the jurisdiction of the committee responsible for its maintenance. Use and enjoy them, don't abuse them. Leave them clean for the next one to enjoy also!

Range officers have the authority to impose sanctions to preserve the safety of the ranges. Any member or guest failing to observe the rules will be

denied ALL range privileges.
