Tenders are responsible for creating a welcoming and fun environment for all customers by providing industry leading service. The position will work directly with the Owners, Assistant Brewers, and other Taproom Bartenders. We dont just "make beer" and "sell beer" we are active, authentic, engaged participants in what makes this life actually enjoyable!

The "JOB"

15-25 hrs/week

Evenings, weekends, holidays shifts are required

Compensation

Hourly Tip Rate starts at \$8.00/hr plus tips, with earning potential to reach \$50+/hr or greater

Terms of employment pay rate is industry standard tip rate, plus tips which are shared evenly between all staff on shift

All tip rate staff will be paid at least hourly minimum wage if shared tips do not satisfy the hourly minimum wage

Pay is "direct deposit" occurring every 2 (two) weeks and deposited on a Friday

Maintain a current SafeServe Servers Certification (or greater equivalent) as is required by ABCC Liquor Law

Maintain a SafeServe Food Certification (or greater equivalent) as required by the Department of Health

Sell draft beer, packaged beer, food, and merchandise to customers

Educate guests about our beers, the 'ethos' of Dirt Church, and encourage responsible enjoyment of our products with meaningful and positive customer service

Proper ID techniques, identifying signs of intoxication, and is proactive to prevent certain avoidable situations known in this industry.

Maintain a *HOSPITAL-LIKE* clean bar, taproom, outdoor seating area, kitchen area, and restrooms

Prepare and serve a very simple food menu

Wash and sanitize glassware and cookware

Assisting in maintaining proper inventory of merchandise

Representing Dirt Church Brewing Co at various events, festivals and/or promotions

Engage meaningfully with the community through this position

This job takes place in person, and on premise

Ability to stand for extended periods of time, walk, use hands to finger, grasp, handle or feel, push, pull, reach, crouch, kneel, crawl or bend, and perform repetitive motions of the hands and/or wrists Ability to exert up to 150 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 10 pounds of force frequently, and/or a negligible amount of force constantly to move objects

Ability to lift and/or move up to 55 pounds and be able to move 165 pounds with assistance if needed (a half barrel keg 15.7 gal weights approx. 165 pounds)

Brewery and Taproom Environment

The employee is subject to inside and/or outside environmental conditions.
