- A dependent relative (spouse, child) or caregiver of a living Service Disabled Veteran
- A dependent relative (spouse, child) of a deceased veteran with status DWRIA,WIA,PKIA
- A dependent relative (spouse, child) of a deceased veteran killed during military related peacetime activity (maneuvers, travel, relief efforts).
- A qualified 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to Veteran support
- A resident or native of the following counties (PA/NY): McKean, Potter, Warren, Forest, Elk, Cameron, Chatauqua, Cattaraugus, Allegany

Applications will be reviewed by VJTT for validity and approved if in keeping with our mission statement. Additional information may be requested, including references and other data, in order to arrive at a decision. **The terms veteran and service-disabled veteran are defined in 38 U.S.C. 101(2) and (16) respectively, the Department of Veterans Affairs, United States Code. The term "veteran" means a person who served in the active military, naval, or air service, and who was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable. The term "service-connected" means, with respect to disability or death, that such disability was incurred or aggravated, or that the death resulted from a disability incurred or aggravated, in line of duty in the active military, naval, or air service. An injury or disease incurred during military service will be deemed to have been incurred in the line of duty unless the disability was caused by the veteran's own misconduct or abuse of alcohol or drugs, or was incurred while absent without permission or while confined by military or civilian authorities for serious crimes.

***Documentation should support the nature of the request (IE, Gas bill, prescription or hospital bill, treatment schedule, et al. If request is of a general nature, please write a succinct description of the reason of the request. VJTT may elect to issue payment in any negotiable form to the veteran, veteran's representative, organization or directly to the agency/entity listed on the bill or supporting documentation. Cash payments will not be offered.
